From M4

- M4 junction 19 take the M32 towards Bristol. Leave the M32 at the first exit, (A4174 signposted Parkway).
- Turn right at the roundabout.
- Proceed along the dual carriageway.
- At Filton Hill round about (junction with A38) go straight across onto B4056 Southmead Road.
- Go straight across the double mini roundabout. The hospital is 250 yards beyond the roundabout on left.

From M5

- At junction 17 leave motorway towards Bristol (W). Take fourth available exit off roundabout on to A4018 (Cribbs Causeway).
- Take second available exit off roundabout onto A4018 (Cribbs Causeway).
- Take first available exit off roundabout on to A4018.
- Take second available exit off roundabout on to A4018 (Passage Road).
- Take third available left on to Greystoke Avenue.
- Turn right at mini-roundabout on to Doncaster Road.
- Turn left on to B4056 (Southmead Road). Arrive at BS10 5NB

Parking: Southmead Hospital has patient and visitor Pay & Display parking. Charges apply 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Southmead Hospital car parking charges:

There are also a few residential areas around the hospital where you can park in the streets/off-road.

How the sessions will be structured:

The teaching session will involve identifying important anatomical landmarks, structures and relations in relevance to common clinical examinations. You will be undertaking this task on another delegate that you will be paired-up with. Within your pairs, you will have the opportunity to identify the landmarks and practice the examinations on each other. The clinical anatomy/examination will involve the following:

- Clinical anatomy and examination of the hip
- · Clinical anatomy and examination of the knee
- Clinical anatomy and examination of the shoulder
- · Clinical anatomy and examination of the hand
- Overview of brachial and lumbo-sacral plexus and examination of nerve injuries in the limbs
- Clinical anatomy and examination of the peripheral arterial system in the lower limb
- Clinical anatomy and examination of the peripheral venous system (varicose veins)
- · Clinical anatomy and examination of the neck and thyroid
- · Clinical anatomy and examination of the abdomen

Dress code:

You are advised to bring with you appropriate clothing (shorts and vest/vest top/short sleeve/singlet). In order to maximize this learning opportunity fairly, all delegates will be expected to take turns at being the model in their pair.

What to prepare: If you have the time, we advise you to read a bit of clinical anatomy. If you brush up your anatomy before the event, you will find the event even more beneficial.

Course material: There is no formal course material. Kindly bring with you a notebook (A5 sized jotter pad) and a pen to note points of interest. Any relevant educational material will be mailed to you after the event.

What you need to bring with you:

- I. A copy of the confirmation mail you received from us with your name. This name should match with your identification badge. Please be informed that you will not be allowed to attend the course without a copy of the confirmation mail.
- II. Your University/Hospital identification badge
- III. Note book and pen

Car Parking

All car parking at the Hospital is managed by OCS Ltd. The Security, Travel & Parking office is open between 8am - 6pm Monday to Friday. The office number is 0117 323 5023.

All visitor parking is Pay & Display. Charges apply 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Tariffs are clearly displayed in all public car parks and can be obtained by calling the Security, Travel & Parking office.

Remember to bring sufficient change to pay for your parking.

For long term parking at a reduced rate contact the Security, Travel & Parking office for more information.

Disabled drivers, displaying a blue badge, park free of charge and disabled parking spaces are provided in most public car parks. If there are no available disabled spaces you may park in any space within a public car park free of charge provided that you display your blue badge. The map overleaf highlights public parking areas. Please ensure that you do not park in staff car parks as only permit holders may park in these areas, particularly as some are barrier controlled and a barrier card is needed to exit them.

Terms and Conditions of parking. Please be advised that failure to comply with the Terms and Conditions of parking as displayed within the car parks may lead to enforcement.
