How the sessions will be structured:

The workshops will use artwork in identifying important surface anatomy landmarks, the structures that lie beneath it and their clinical/operative significance. This involves drawing surface anatomy structures on another delegate that you will be paired-up with. Within your pairs, you will have the opportunity to practice drawing on each other. Body surfaces that you will be practicing on include the face, neck, chest, abdomen, arms and legs (chest will be used only in male participants). We will provide washable marker pens to be used on the skin. Appropriate wipes will also be provided to remove the ink. If you are allergic to any sort of marker pen/ink on your skin, kindly inform us beforehand.

Dress code:

You must bring with you appropriate clothing (shorts and vest/vest top/crop top/short sleeve/singlet) +/- wear old clothing/bring a spare set of clothes. In order to maximize this learning opportunity fairly, all delegates will be expected to take turns at being the model in their pair.

If you have the time, we advise you to read a bit of clinical anatomy. If you brush up your anatomy before the event, you will find the event even more beneficial.

Course material:

There is no formal course material. Kindly bring with you a notebook (A5 sized jotter pad) and a pen to note points of interest. Any relevant educational material will be mailed to you after the event.

Will be provided during the morning and afternoon breaks. Lunch is not provided nor is included in the course fee. Kindly make your own arrangements for lunch.
