Dubai UAE: MRCS Part B OSCE International Course

This course is suitable for candidates appearing for the Intercollegiate MRCS Part B (OSCE Exam) that is conducted by the three Royal College of Surgeons in the United Kingdom (England, Edinburgh and Glasgow) and separately by the Royal College of Surgeons of Ireland. The course is structured to cover as many as 16 out of the 18 OSCE stations in the exam.

Day One - Applied Basic Sciences for MRCS Part B OSCE

Day one provides the candidates with a sound understanding of applied surgical anatomy, surgical pathology, applied pharmacology and microbiology, and a good working knowledge of general physiological principles/critical care with their application to surgical practice examined. Due to the large number of topics that will be covered, the day will be intense and the candidates will be expected to have revised basic science topics within a month of attendance in this course. This day will cover 8 out of 18 OSCE stations in the exam covering the 'Clinical Knowledge and Its Application' component.

Day Two - Clinical Examination for MRCS Part B/ OSCE

Day two consolidated the trainee's understanding of the clinical consultation skills component of the exam, and aided the trainee's ability to perform clinical examinations efficiently whilst presenting their findings to the examiner in a systematic yet concise manner. This day covered approximately 4 out of 18 stations in the exam that cover the 'Clinical and Physical Examination' component.

Candidates attending this course will receive full access to MRCS Part B online educational resources from www.doctorexams.co.uk for a 4 month period. This resource contains a number of OSCE questions in anatomy, pathology and physiology for practice. It also contains information on clinical and procedural skills, and clinical examination. In addition, they will also receive full access to all presentations via a secure, online link. All these benefits and privileges are included within the course fee.

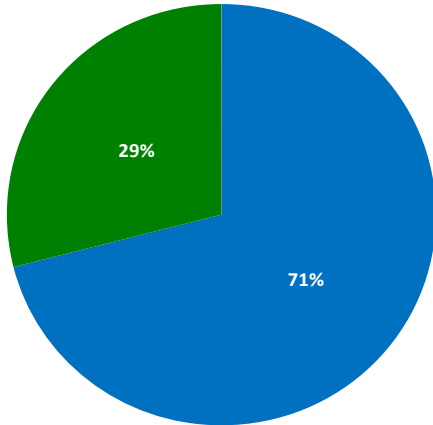


Day Three - Communication Skills for MRCS Part B/OSCE

Day 3 covered structured interviews, information giving, information gathering, breaking bad news and consenting for operations/procedures. Patient-centered clinical scenarios were used to reflect situations in everyday practice; these scenarios being in line with the scenarios commonly tested in the exam. There was the opportunity for all participants to engage in a number of role-play scenarios. With the day covering approximately 4 out of 18 stations in the exam, including the 'Communication Skills' component (that contains giving and receiving information; history taking).

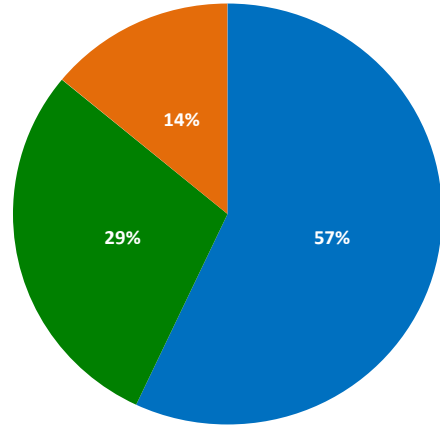

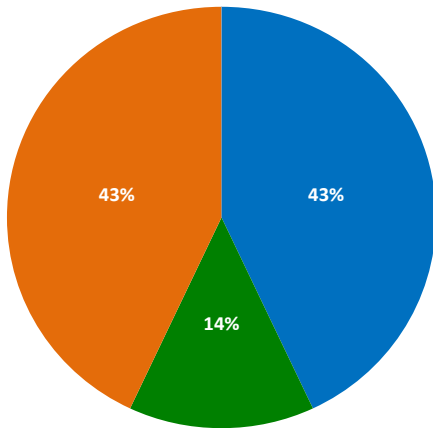

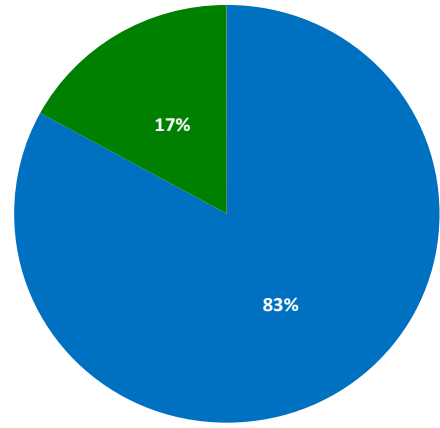

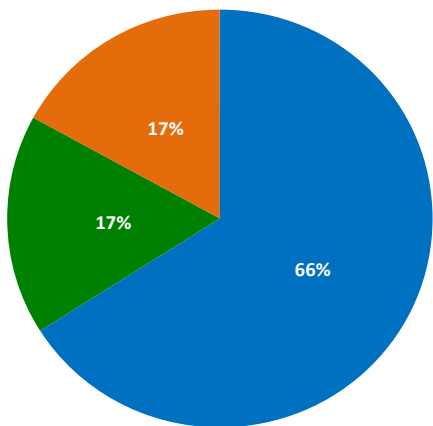

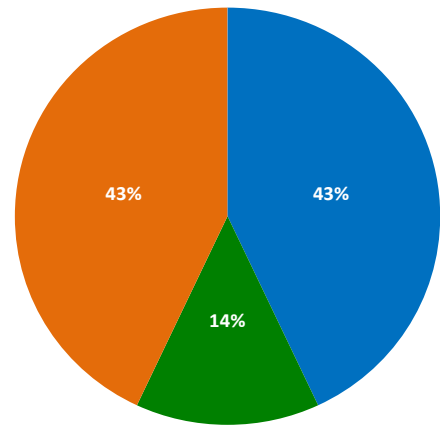

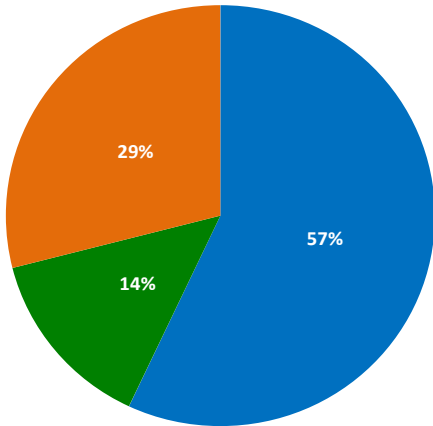

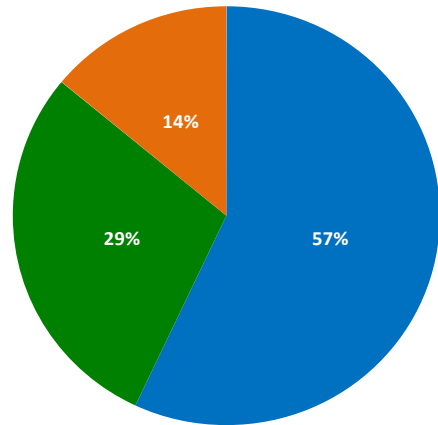

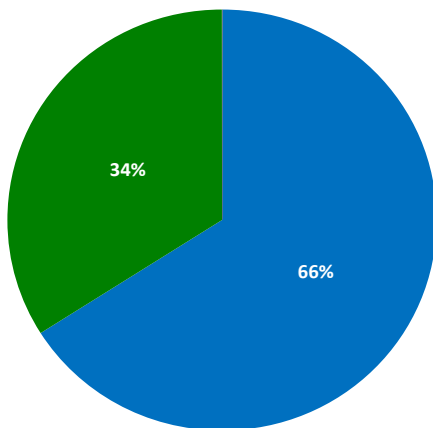

Your overall score for the Course



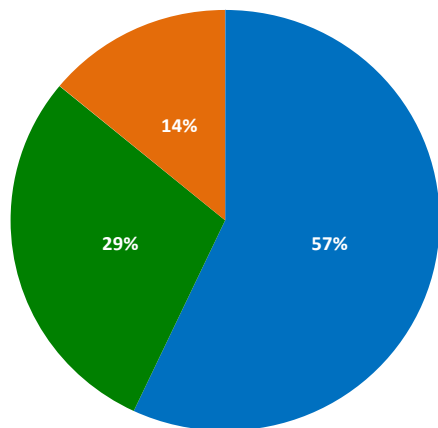

How was the usefulness of communication Scenarios?



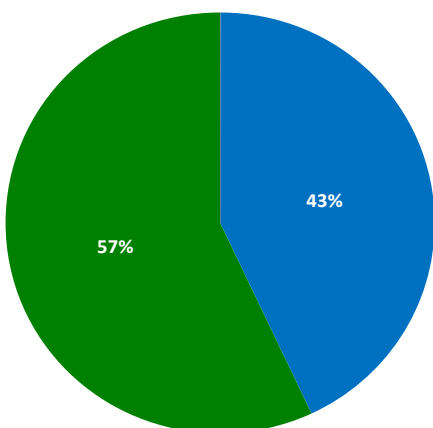

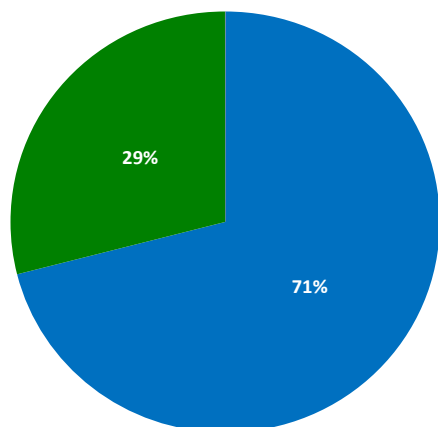

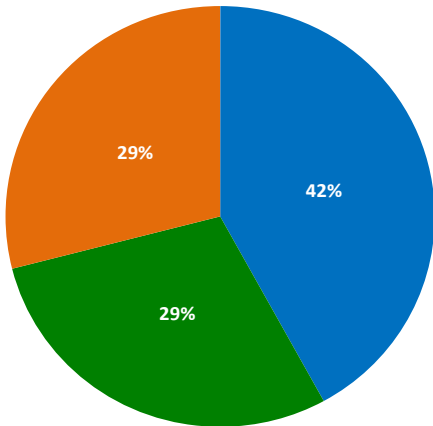

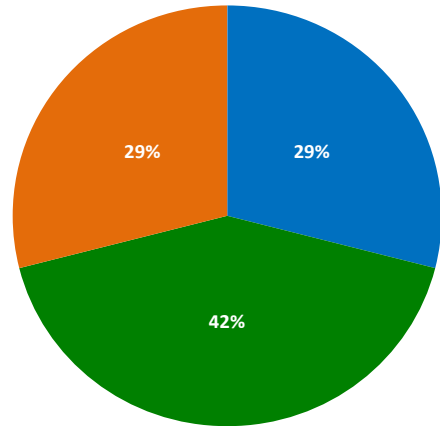

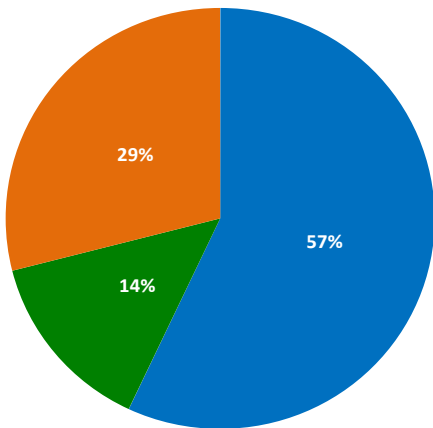

Carcinoid Cancer



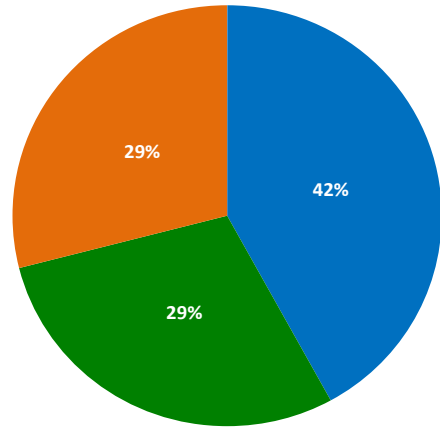

Carcinoid of Appendix



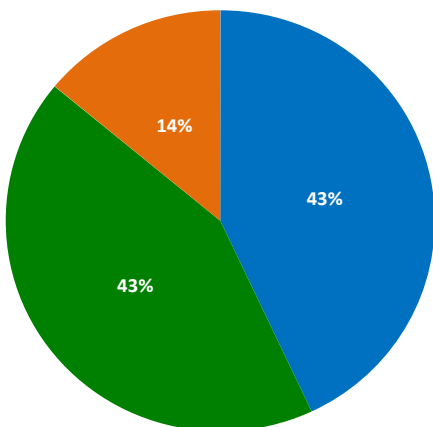

Peripheral Arterial Disease



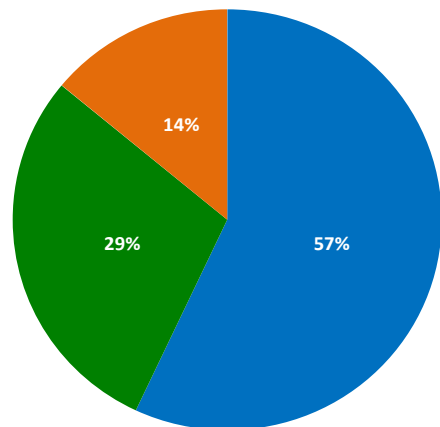

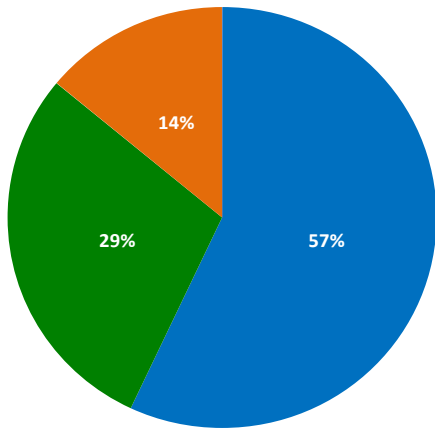

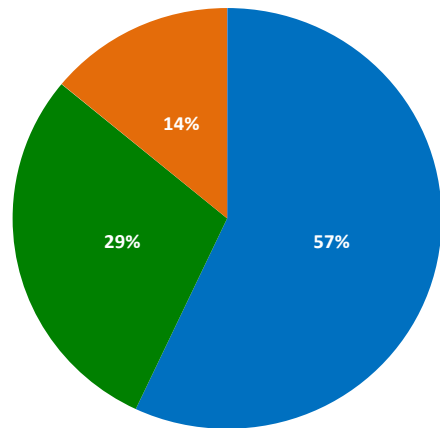

How useful was the demonstration of the Branchial Plexus?



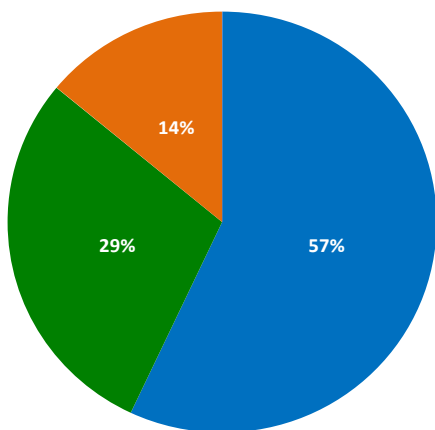

How useful was the demonstration of clinical examinations?



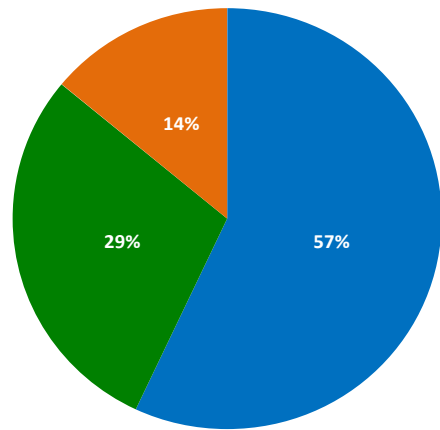

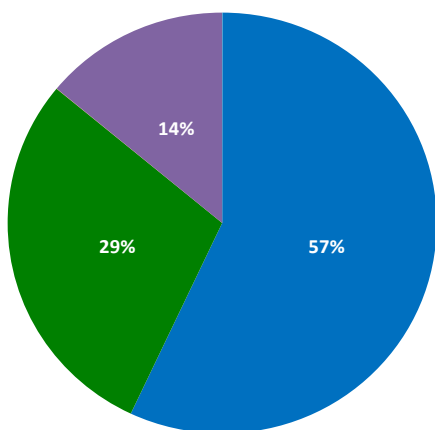

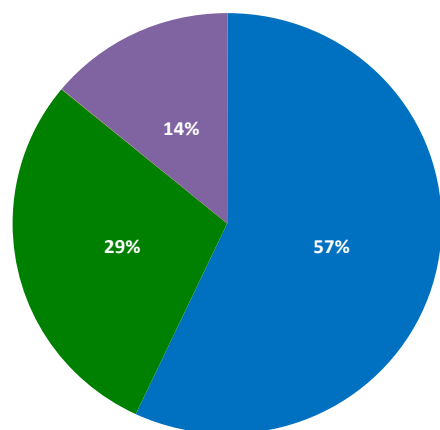

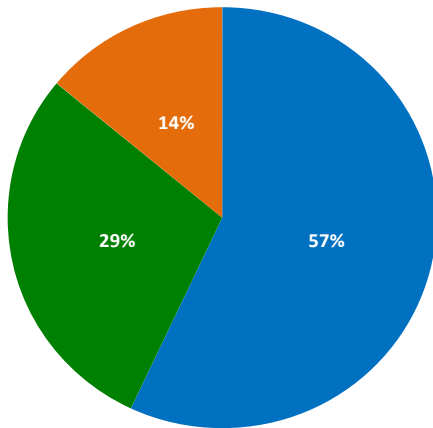
Varicose Vein

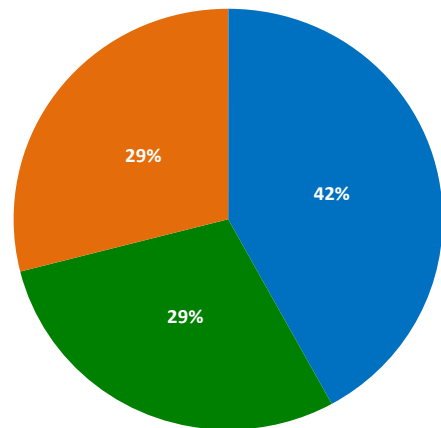

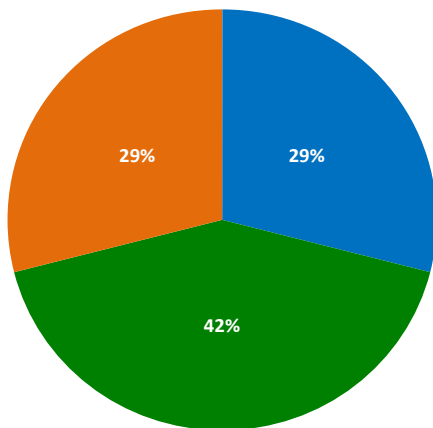

Nerve Injury



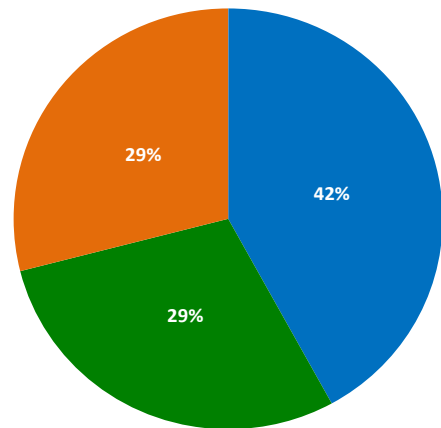

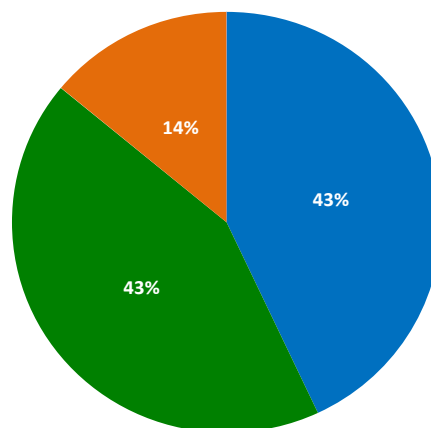
