Conference Format and Content:

You will then have the opportunity to participate in three different practical workshops. Each session will last for 45 minutes, with one to be held before lunch and two to be held in the afternoon. Following the first workshop, there will be a talk from Mr Adam Williams.

The poster presentations will take place during the lunch break. The afternoon session will comprise of two workshops which will be separated by a talk from Professor Azfar Zaman and Professor Stephan Schuyler.

The day will conclude with a talk by Mr Declan Costello and the Prize Giving Ceremony.
