I. General and reporting

Date:

24th January 2015

Venue:

Dissection Room and E1.03, Anatomy Department, School of Biosciences 2, Cardiff University

Start time:

The course will start promptly at 0845 hrs. The lecture theatre desk will be open from 0830 hours for registration. Please be prompt as the course will start on time.

Finish time:

The course will finish at approximately 1830 hrs. If you are planning to book a train, please do so for a train from 1930 hours onwards.

Where to report:

Please enter the School of Biosciences 2 in **Sir Martin Evans building** from the main entrance. Please walk up the ramp either from the 'museum avenue' side or the 'Colum Road' side and enter the main School of Biosciences 2 building. The building is a short walk from the 'Main Building of the University', 'Students Union', 'Cathays train station', and is behind the 'Security Centre'. Once you enter **Sir Martin Evans building** please report to the security and ask them to direct you to C0.12. If you arrive after 1000 hours please report straight to the Anatomy Dissection Room.

Dress code:

Accommodation:

If you need accommodation, you may consider the options below. The venue where the course is held is very close to the city centre. The University is about 6-8 min walk from the city centre. Cardiff Bay is quite far from the venue and we would hence suggest you not to book your accommodation in Cardiff Bay (unless you wish to stay there due to other reasons). We recommend a few accommodations nearby:

Both the travel lodges are quite close by. However, the one in city centre can be busy during the evenings/night and you may get disturbed. Thus the one in Whitchurch might be better. It will cost about £7-£8 by cab to the University.
