



Obstetrics & Gynaecology OSCE Revision Course

This course is a highly successful revision resource for 4th year and final year medical students who are preparing for the Obstetrics and Gynaecology stations of the OSCE examinations.

The course was led by Mr Hani J Shuheibar, consultant in Obstetrics and Gynaecology. He has led and supported a similar course for over eight years in conjunction with Manchester medical student societies.

Saturday consisted of concise revision lectures relevant to the Obstetrics and Gynaecology OSCE examinations. The lectures encompassed different aspects of the speciality frequently examined and were all delivered by consultant obstetricians and gynaecologists who are also trained OSCE examiners. Delegates were given the opportunity to ask questions and discuss the topics throughout the day.

Sunday focused on skills-based stations which were centred on the themes which commonly occur in the exam. Teaching was delivered by speciality trainee doctors and was overseen by consultants and clinical skills tutors.

Students who have attended this course have found the days very enlightening and useful. They feel that it has given them the opportunity to gain confidence in their theoretical and practical understanding of the field.

This is a non-profit course. All proceeds were donated to support medical student electives and experience placements in Gulu, Northern Uganda. Some proceeds also went to supporting medical education at Gulu University and to orphans in Gulu.




How would you rate the general academic standard of the lecturers?


