














Parking:

Course format/content:

The morning session will consist of three keynote speakers from rural surgery, obstetrics and gynaecology and plastic surgery. There will also be oral presentations from four students. These students were selected after submitting an abstract of their work for consideration. Following a hot lunch, the afternoon session will be on clinical workshops. Delegates will get the opportunity to participate in 4 workshops. These are: (i) Tendon repair/elliptical wound closure, (ii) plaster casts, (iii) cannulation and, (iv) either suturing or intraosseous access.
