

Training the Clinical Anatomy Trainer – Level 2

(Part of Certification as Clinical or Surgical Anatomist)

**This is a second level course for certification
as a clinical or surgical anatomist.**

Taught by surgeons and surgical anatomists, the 'Training Clinical Anatomy Trainer Level 2' course aims to provide attendees with a further understanding of applied clinical anatomy pertinent to qualified doctors and anatomists. The course will include both teaching and assessment using prosections and osteology in the anatomy dissection room. The course will comprise of a series of assessments on teaching techniques interspersed with short interactive lectures over the two days.

Assessment of teaching will be in the following areas:

- Small group teaching/presentation to a simulated undergraduate audience
- Small group teaching/presentation to a simulated postgraduate audience
- Large group teaching/presentation
- Prosection-based teaching
- Basic osteology teaching
- PPT assessment of spotters
