- Surgical anatomy of the thoracic inlet, mediastinum, diaphragm and intercostals;
Osteology of sternum, first rib and clavicle
Viva/OSCE on the above topics

- Surgical anatomy of the anterior abdominal wall, inguinal region, external genitalia and solid viscera (liver, spleen, kidneys)
Viva/OSCE on abdominal wall and solid organs
- Surgical anatomy of the head and face; osteology of face (including orbit) and base of skull
Viva/OSCE on the above topics

*Topographical and surface anatomy will also be demonstrated.
Appropriate radiographs and other imaging will be used as aids.*
