





Doctors Academy Preparation Course for BMAT

Given the disruption to the A-Level exams and the continued unpredictability brought by COVID-19, obtaining a high score in the BioMedical Admissions Test (BMAT) is even more essential for those applying to medical school in 2022. This interactive two-day course provided focused information on how to approach each section of the BMAT.

Through a comprehensive discussion of 100s of questions, it highlighted how to answer each type of question, how to answer within the stipulated time, and how to avoid common pitfalls. It also helped the attendee to develop his or her own strategies to answer the various questions that appear in the test.

It is envisaged that, with adequate structured and focused revision by the attendee until the test, the course will have enabled him or her to aim for a score of 5.5 to 6 in Sections 1 and 2, and 4A to 4.5A in Section 3.

- o Section 1 (Problem Solving; Critical Thinking)
- o Section 2 (Scientific Knowledge: Biology; Chemistry; Physics; and Mathematics)
- o Section 3 (Writing Task)




Section 2: Chemistry








Day 2: Section 1: Problem Solving




Section 1: Critical Thinking




