Directions

The conference will be held in the Williams Room of the John McIntyre Building at The University of Glasgow. The building is situated at the top of the hill of University Gardens, incorporated into the main gates. Delegated should enter via University Avenue and will find the Williams Room at the top of the staircase inside this entrance.

Travel

From Carlisle, Newcastle and the south, exit M74 on to the M73, joining the M8 at the Old Monkland junction. M8 exits for the University are J18 if travelling from the south, Edinburgh and the north and J19 if coming from Glasgow Airport and the west. Other main routes serving the University include Great Western Road (A82, north of campus), Clydeside Expressway (A814, south) and Byres Road (B808, west). Campus is easily accessible by subway from either Hillhead Station or Kelvinbridge Subway station which are both within 5 minute walking distance of the venue (more details can be found at http://www.spt.co.uk/subway/)

Parking

On campus parking is limited to permit holders. There are various pay & display parking spaces around the local Byres Road and Kelvin Way areas but spaces are limited. You may want to consider using the city's Subway Park & Ride scheme. This service costs around £5 and Kelvinbridge subway station has parking which is only a 5-minute walk away.
