II. DIRECTIONS

- There is a direct bus service (number 147) that runs every 10 minutes from Manchester Piccadilly Railway Station. This bus service alights outside "Library".
- Buses from Manchester City Centre are very regular. Please use bus numbers 15, 42, 43, 142 or 143 and alight at Manchester Royal Infirmary on Oxford Road.

Parking:

- Event attendees must park in the multi-storey car park on **Hathersage Road**. This car park is called **Hathersage Road Multi-Storey**.
- Please walk from the car park along Hathersage Road towards Oxford Road. Before reaching Oxford Road, turn right into the hospital grounds. You will be able to see the Children's Hospital to your right.
- Walk down the roadway to the Undergraduate Education Centre. The receptionist will direct you to the appropriate room.
- At the end of the event, kindly take your car parking ticket to the Security Lodge in the car park and present your hospital ID badge. The security staff will reduce your car parking charge to £5 for the full day.
- Please note that, if you park in the multi-storey car park on Grafton Street, you will be liable for the full £15 charge for parking. There are no reduced rates for the Grafton Street Multi-Storey.

III. WHAT TO PREPARE

The course will be intense and exhausting. Please read as much as possible beforehand so that you will gain the maximum benefit from the course. Prior knowledge will also help you to focus on important pieces of information during the lectures. Day 1 of the course will mainly focus on Applied Basic Sciences, which makes up 60% of the exam (180 questions), and Day 2 will focus on Principles of Surgery in General, which makes up 40% of the exam (120 questions).
