### Birmingham Hand Fracture Fixation Course

This course was aimed at core trainees and specialist trainees, as well as hand fellows. The morning session consisted of focused lectures, whilst the afternoon comprised of a practical workshop that taught the attendee how to plate hand fractures.

The lectures discussed fundamental topics, including the biology of fracture healing, principles of such a fixation, the management of common hand fractures, and hand therapy in fracture management.

The afternoon session used synthetic bones and DePuy Synthes Compact Hand System, which included the new variable angle locking plate system. There were also group discussions during which individual factors and management options were discussed.










DePuy Synthes Sawbone Session (VA)

Scaphoid/Distal Radius # + Cases





