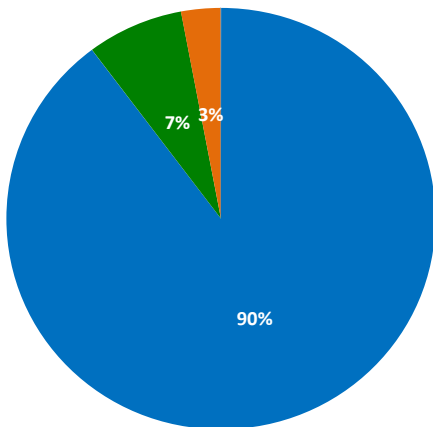

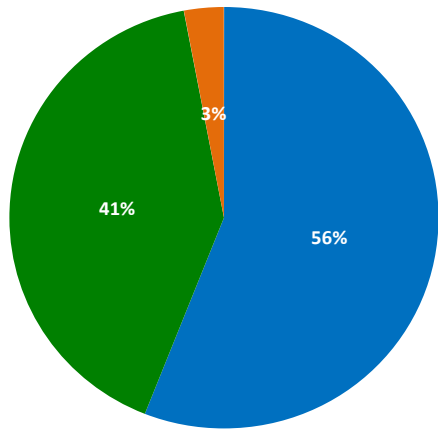

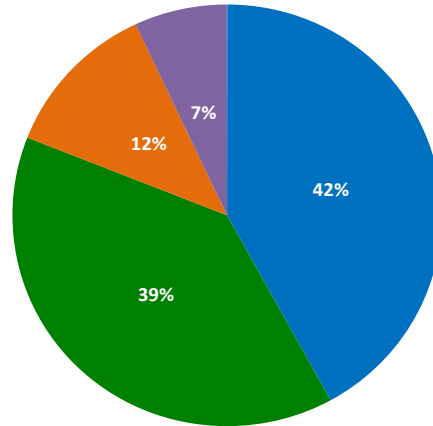

How do you rate the relevance of the event to your future career?



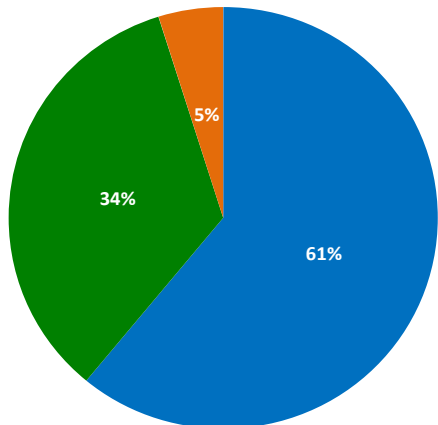

Do you feel that the event will help you in your future career choices?



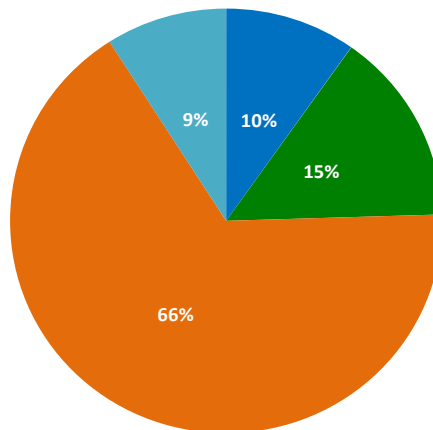

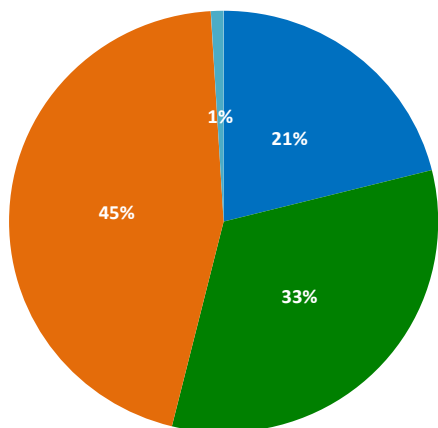

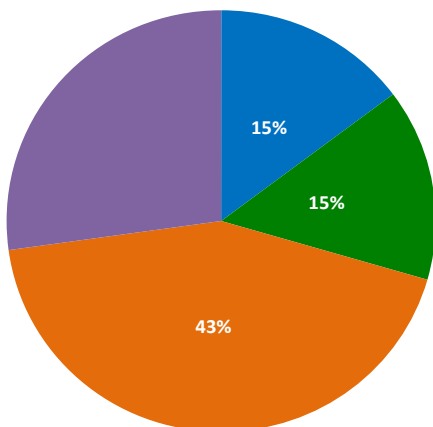

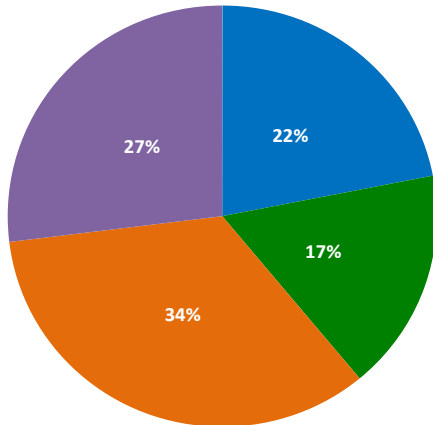

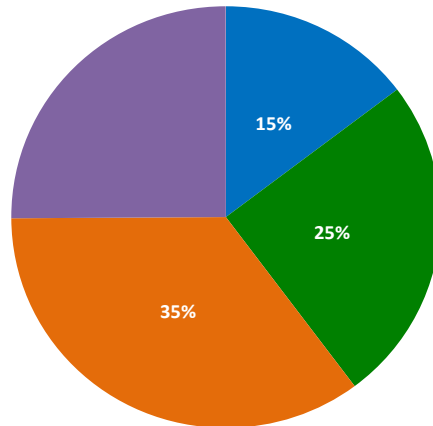

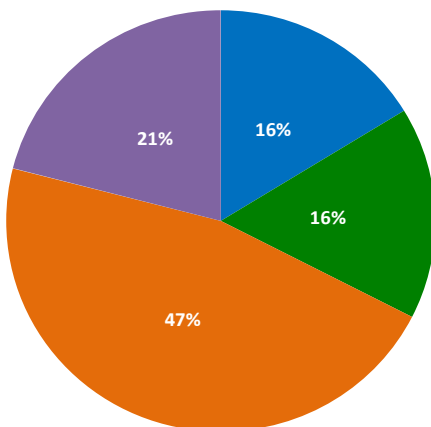

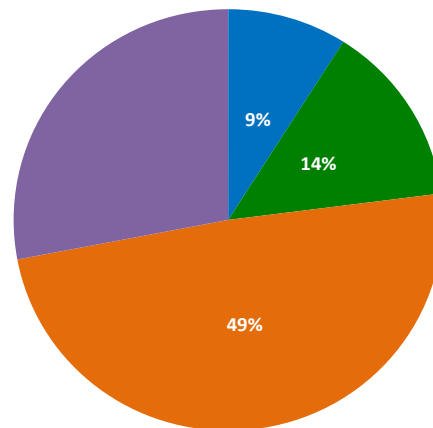

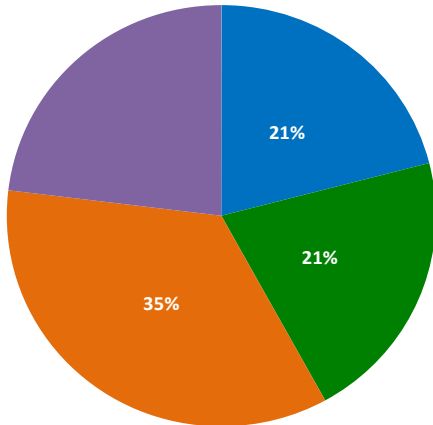

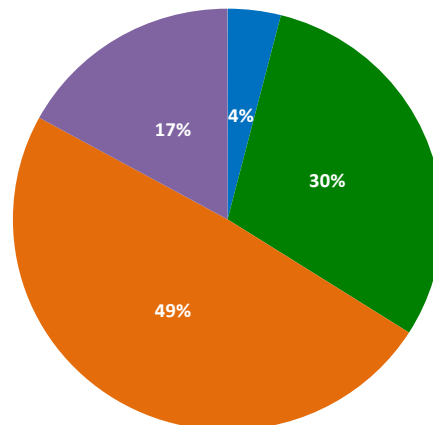

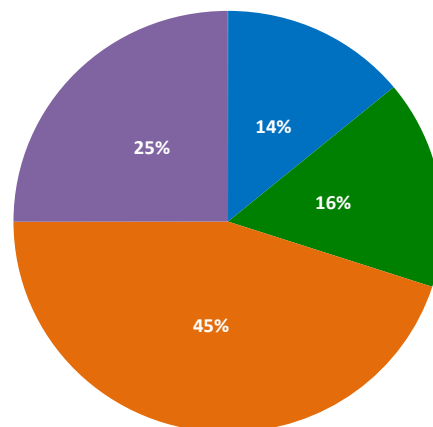

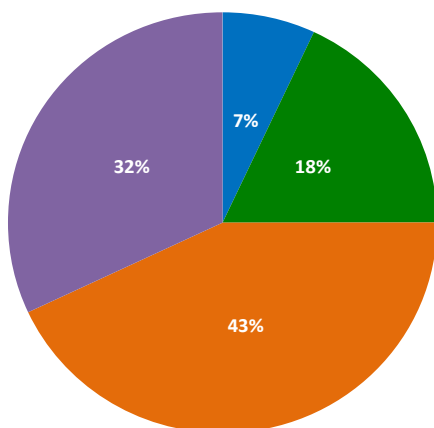

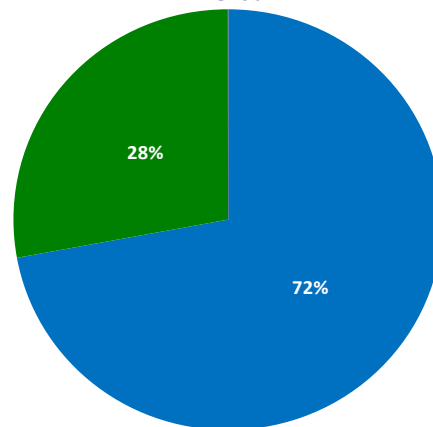
