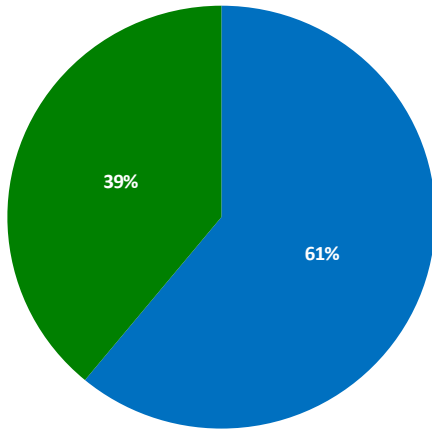

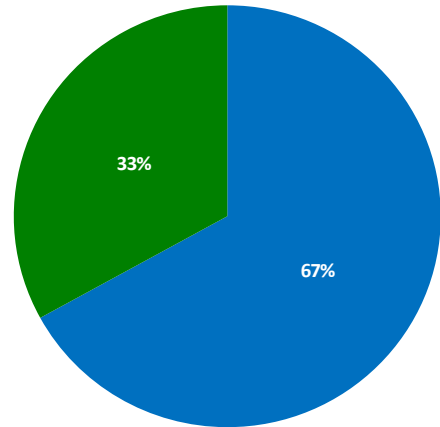

How was the content of the conference?



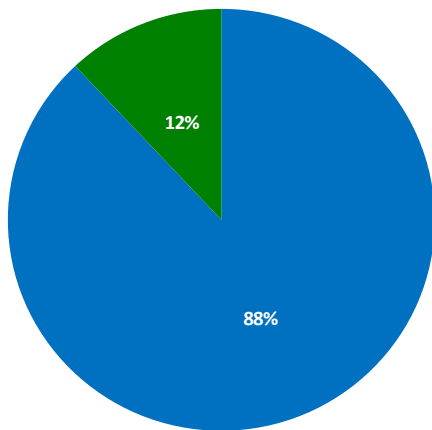

How would you rate the general academic standard of the speakers?



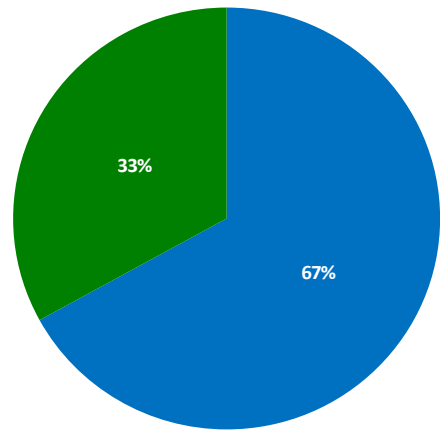

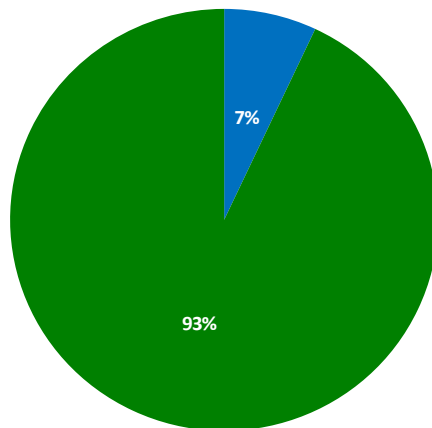

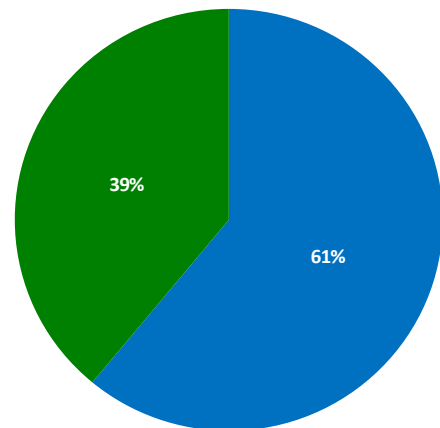
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Differing Needs of Trans People Accessing Sexual Health Services – Mx C.J. Reay

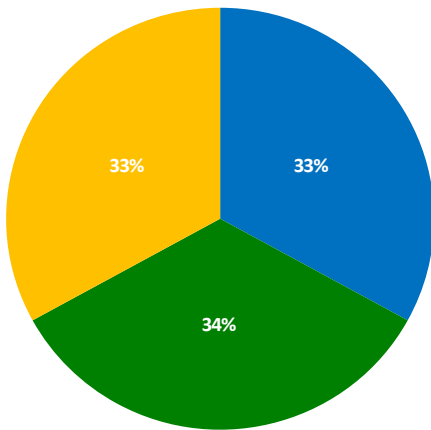

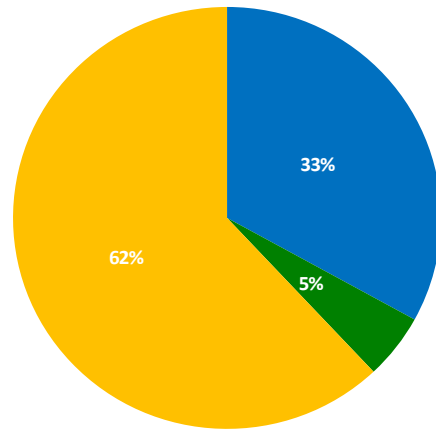

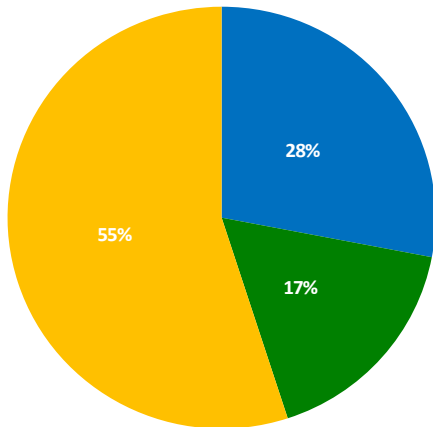
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Gynae History Taking



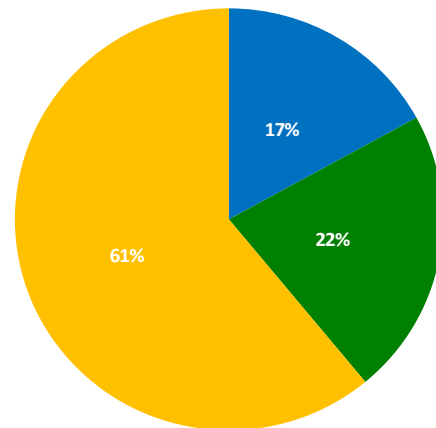
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Neonatal Resus in a Developing Country



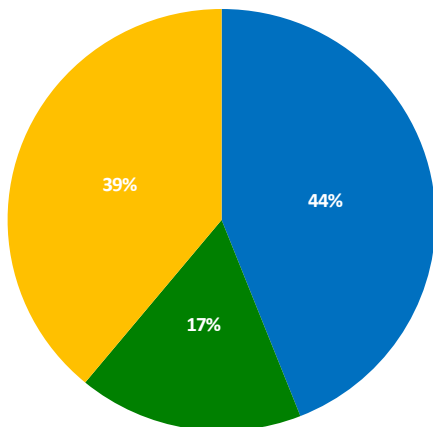

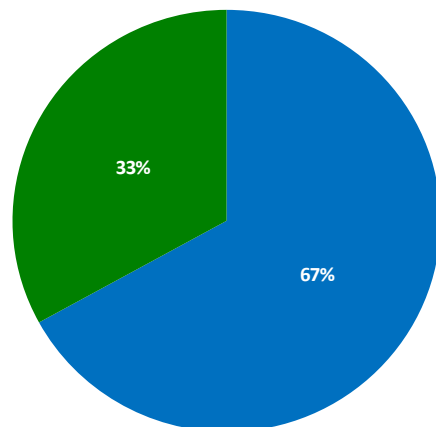
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Speculum and Bimanual Vaginal Examination Skills

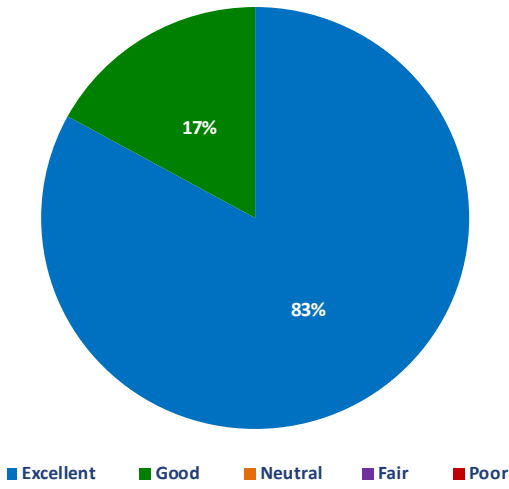

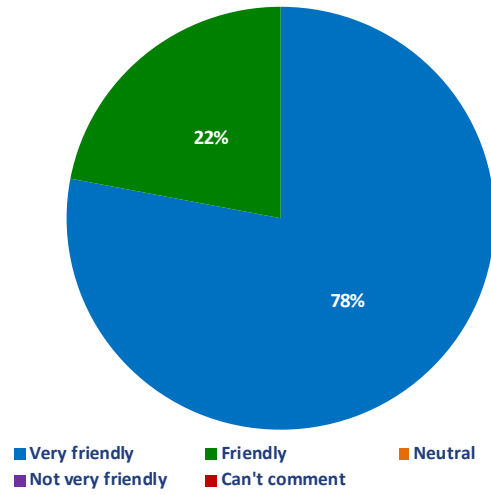

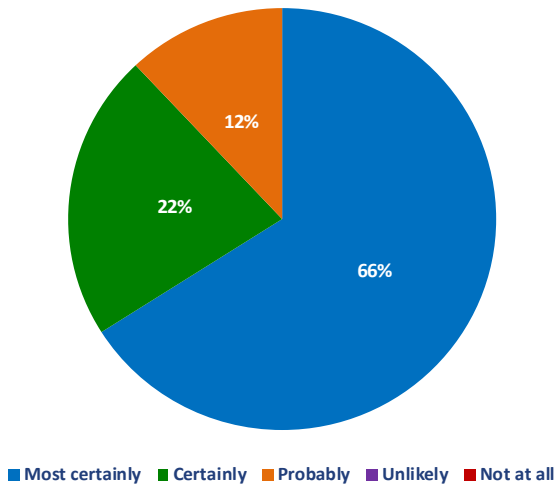

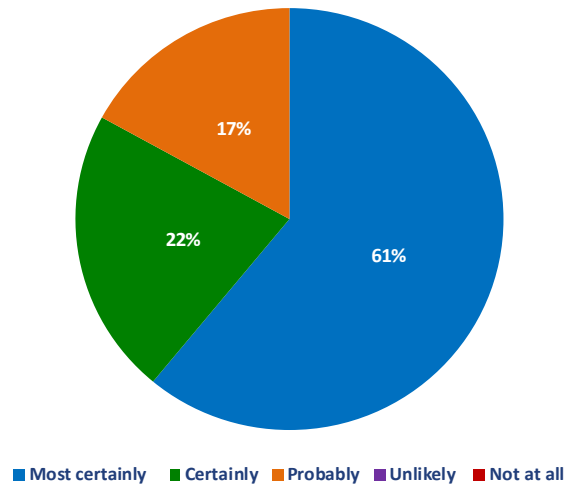
