




How was the content of the course?




How would you rate the general academic standard of the faculty?




How was the clarity of the demonstrations?




Did the course meet your objectives?



How would you rate the academic standard of the competition?




How would you rate the usefulness of the competition to your learning?











How were the refreshments and lunch?






