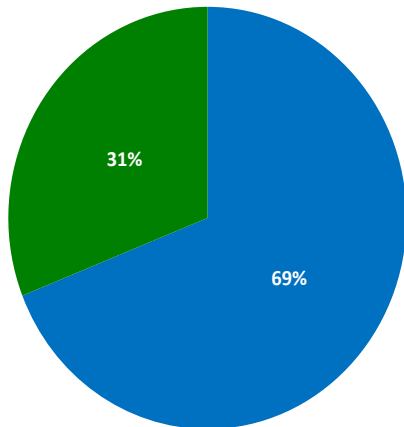

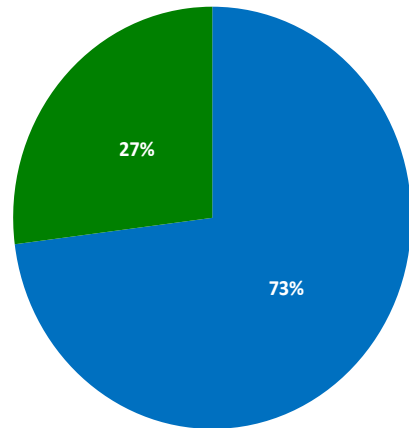

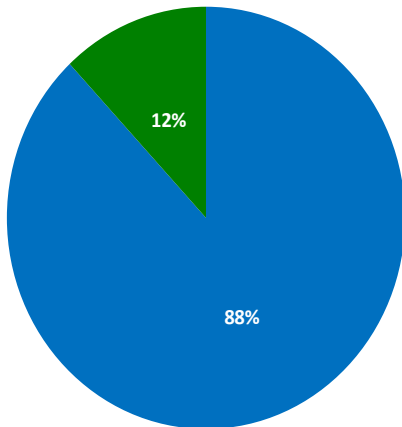

How would you rate the general academic standard of the speakers?



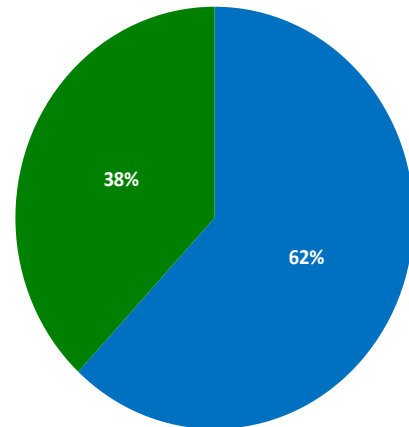

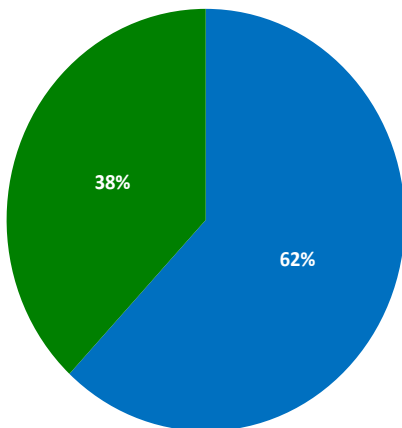

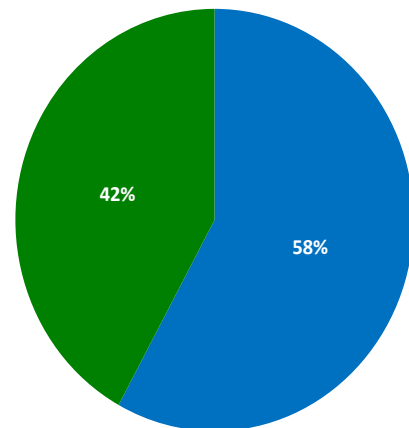

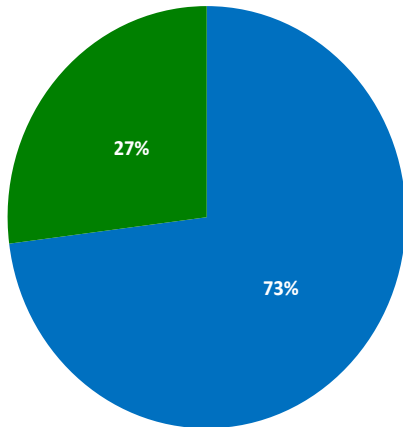

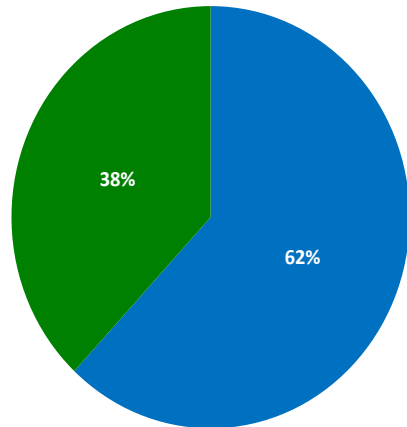

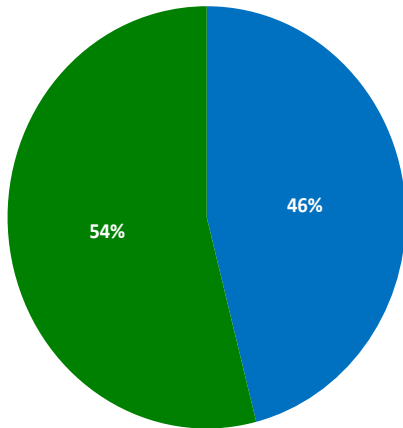

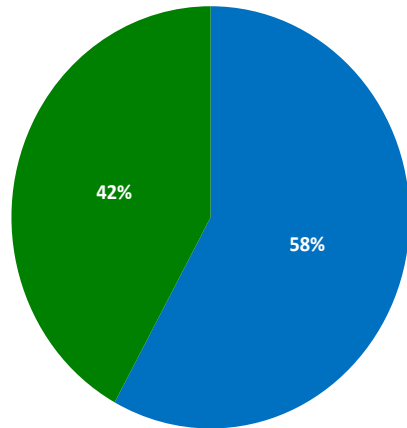

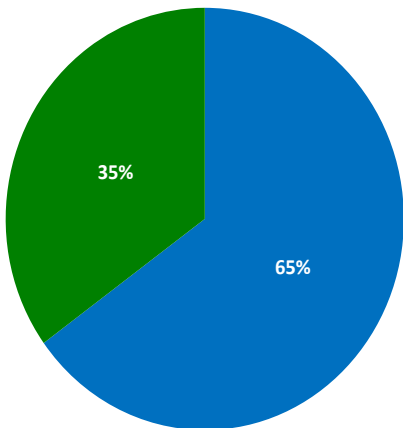

Basic Obstetrics and Gynaecology Skills – Dr Glenn Davies



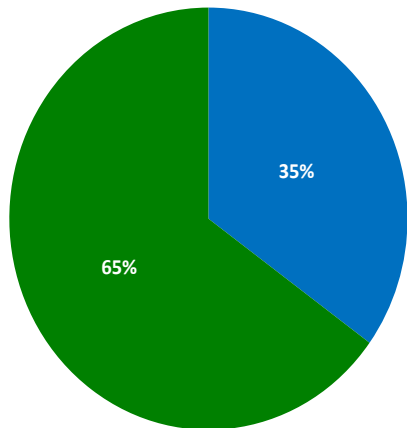

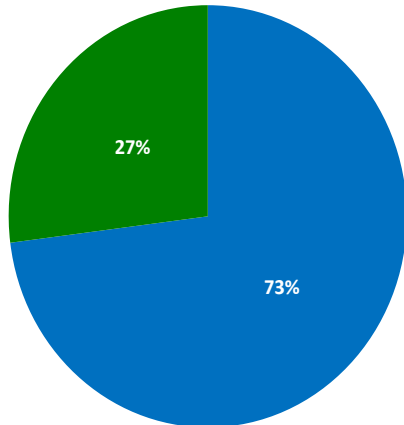

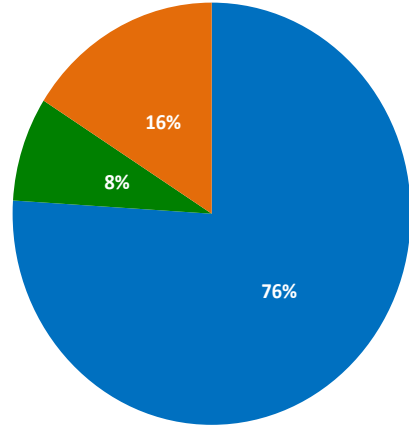

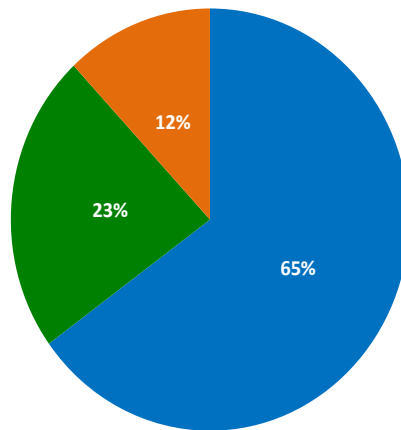
