Where to Report:

When you arrive at Edgbaston Park Hotel and Conference Centre, please ask the receptionist to direct you to the appropriate room.

II. ADDRESS, DIRECTIONS AND PARKING

Directions:

By Car:

Approaching from the northwest or southeast along the M6:

- Leave at Junction 6 (signposted Birmingham Central) to join the A38 (M).
- Continue on the A48, and then take the B4127.
- Turn left onto Wheeley's Lane.
- Continue straight until you reach the hotel (on your right).

Approaching from the M42 north:

- Leave at Junction 8 to join the M6 northbound.
- Follow the instructions above.

Approaching from the southwest:

Leave the M5 at Junction 4 signposted Birmingham SW to join the A38.

Approaching from the M40:

- From Junction 3A, head west on the M42.
- At Junction 3, take the A435 exit (Birmingham South).

Parking:

Complimentary parking is available at the hotel. Upon arrival, please collect a parking permit from reception. Parking is available directly outside the hotel, or on the ground floor of the 'North East Multi-Storey Car Park' (entrance on Pritchatts Road), which is reserved solely for hotel guests.

By Train:

- As you exit University Station, turn left towards the University of Birmingham's campus.
- Continue to follow the road (Westgate) down the hill without crossing over; you will walk past some car parks, which are now boarded up.
- At the end of this road, turn left onto Ring Road North and walk up the hill, passing behind the Main Library and Teaching and Learning building.
- At the top of the road, turn right onto Pritchatts Road and cross at the pedestrian crossing.
- Continue walking on Pritchatts Road until you see the entrance of the multi-storey North East Car Park.
- Turn left here and walk past the Centre for Human Brain Health (CHBH).
- Edgbaston Park Hotel will be on your left.

III. PRE-COURSE MATERIAL

You will have already gained access to the pre-course online material and videos from the College. This is provided to give you a background to the course, as well as additional theoretical knowledge. While the material and videos should be viewed prior to the course, it is primarily meant for you to practice exercises after the course. It is important that you do not practice exhaustively from the online material alone as specific exercises will be demonstrated during the course. These may differ slightly in method from that shown online.
