#### How the day will be structured:

The day will be divided into two components. The morning session will comprise of interactive discussions and lectures in a variety of relevant surgical topics and management of common emergencies. The afternoon session will include demonstration of commonly tested clinical examinations. The students will be divided into three groups and you will rotate through the stations covering the various examinations. The tutor will demonstrate the examination first and will expect the students to practice it on each other under direct supervision.

Clinical examinations that will be taught include:

- Hernias, scrotal and groin swellings
- Abdomen
- Peripheral arterial disease
- Peripheral venous disease (varicose veins)
- Neck lumps/Thyroid
- Breast
- Lymph nodes
- Joint examinations

#### Morning session – informal.

**Afternoon sessions** – also informal but you may consider bringing with you appropriate clothing (shorts and vest/vest top/crop top/short sleeve/singlet) for practicing clinical examinations.
