
This intensive one-day clinical examination course was specially tailored to assist fourth and final year medical students prepare for the OSCE component of the exam in April 2014. Taught by physicians and surgeons, this course provided the students with a focused revision of the most common OSCE scenarios tested in the exam. It aimed to enhance the candidate's ability to obtain a focused history, interpret relevant data, communicate effectively, and perform clinical examinations slickly and present the findings to the examiner in a systematic & concise manner. In addition, the candidates used this course to consolidate their previously acquired knowledge, streamlined their thought process and obtained essential exam-preparation tips from the clinicians. The teaching was conducted in the format of small group teaching/mock OSCE, focusing on the essential topics. Every candidate had the opportunity to participate in mock OSCE scenarios throughout the day.


The candidates seem to have enjoyed the course and benefitted from it. The collated summary of the feedback is summarised in the subsequent pages.














