

Surgical Revision Course & Mock Exam for Final Year Medical Students

This intensive one day revision course is specifically tailored to assist final year medical students prepare for the surgical component of their final exam.

Taught by practicing surgeons, the course aims to consolidate a student's knowledge whilst addressing any weaknesses, provide a focused revision of pertinent surgical topics, and aid the candidate's ability to perform clinical examinations (OSCE) slickly and present the findings to the examiner in a systematic yet concise manner.

In addition to a series of interactive lectures, there will be was a 75-minute mock exam at the end of the course that covers the written component of the exam (progress test, SBA, data interpretation, patient management problem and OSCE).


The course, amongst others, will cover the following areas:

- Overview of joint replacement procedures



















Inguinal Region and Hernia










How was the clarity of the lectures?




