#### **ABOUT THE EVENT**

# **Brief Description:**

The day will start with a theory based assessment of basic clinical anatomy. There will be 30 questions in PPT format. This score will not be used in the final evaluation. In addition to covering the essential anatomical aspects and principles in the assessment of trauma victims and common operative procedures, there will be interactive sessions on wound healing, local anaesthesia and sutures. The day will end with a formal assessment that will be carried out using PPT based spotters, clinical scenarios and a short viva exam. You will be assessed only on the areas that were taught during the course.

#### The Structure of the Sessions:

A combination of lectures, interactive discussions and surface anatomy demonstration will be included. Volunteers will be used for surface anatomy demonstration.
