Parking:

'Pay and display' car parks are available in the hospital premises. Car Park 3 is the car park for the West Wing. Unfortunately, there is no free parking available on the streets nearby as all areas are under council parking restrictions. The Thornhill Park & Ride service would provide a suitable alternative for all day parking with the number '400' bus connecting Thornhill Park & Ride to Headington Shops, from where the hospital site is a 15 minute walk.

ABOUT THE EVENT

Brief description: The day will start with a theory based assessment (formative exam) of basic clinical anatomy. There will be 30 questions in PPT format. This score will not be used in the final evaluation. In addition to covering the essential anatomical aspects and principles in the assessment of trauma victims and common operative procedures, there will be interactive sessions on wound healing, local anaesthesia and sutures. The day will end with a formal assessment that will be carried out using PPT based spotters and viva.

Format and structure of teaching:

The teaching session will be structured as a combination of lectures, interactive discussions and surface anatomy demonstration. Volunteers will be used for surface anatomy demonstration.
