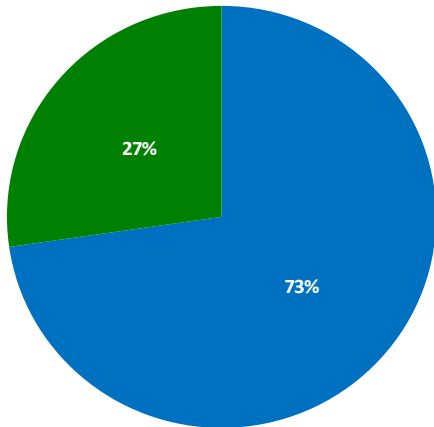

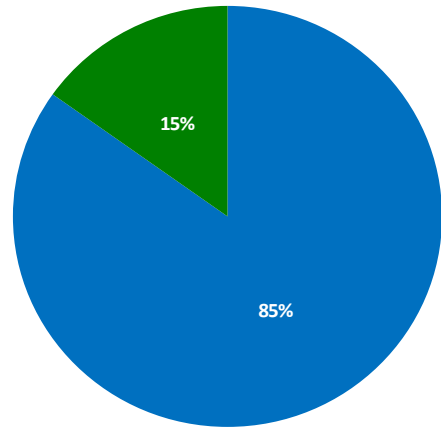

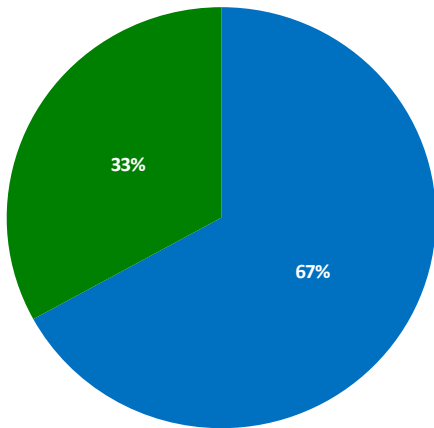

How would you rate the general academic standard of the tutors?



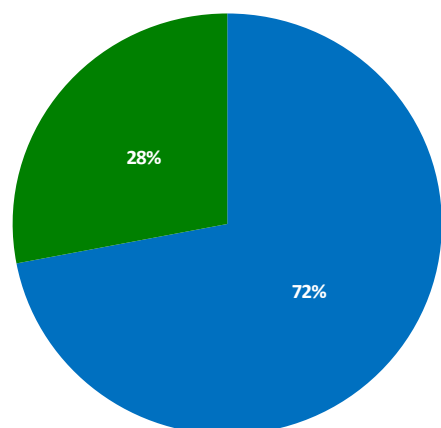

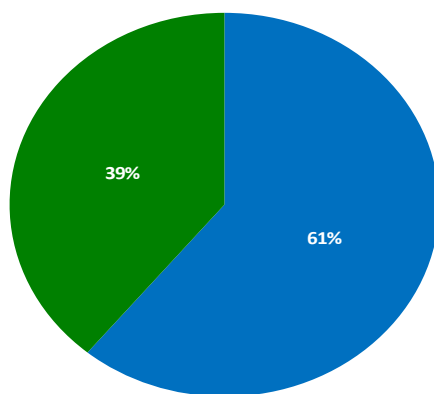

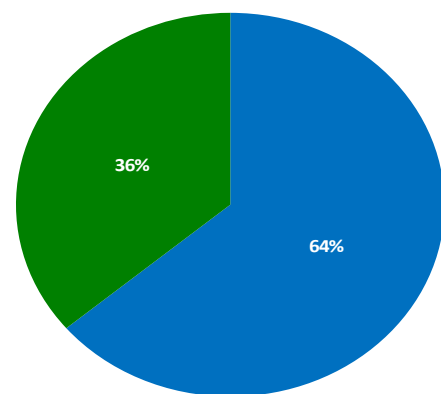

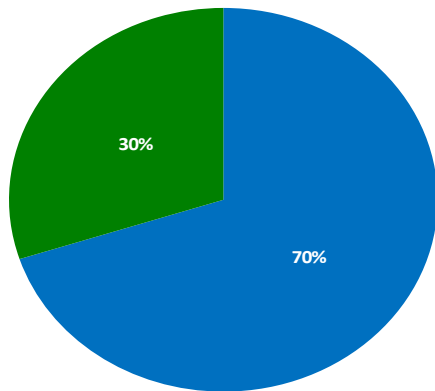

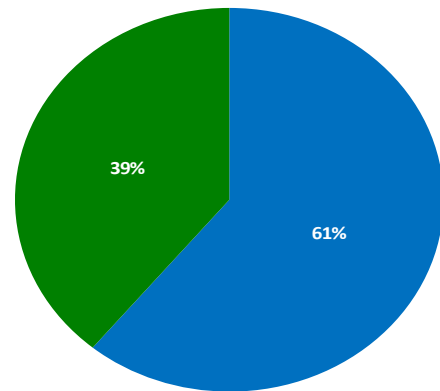

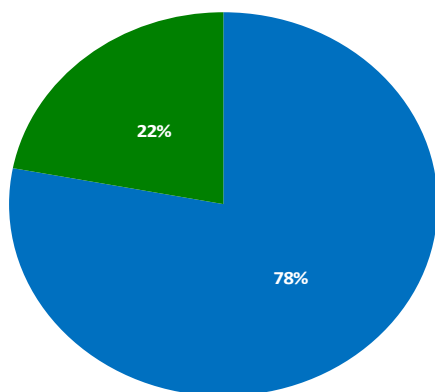

Hand Surgery: The Frontier of Orthoplastics



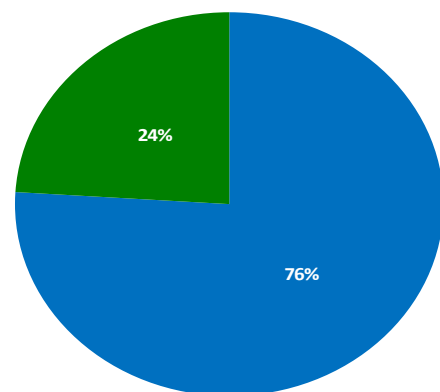

Workshop 1 - Internal Fixation



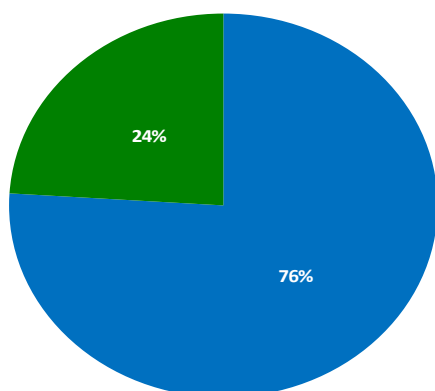

Workshop 2 - External Fixation



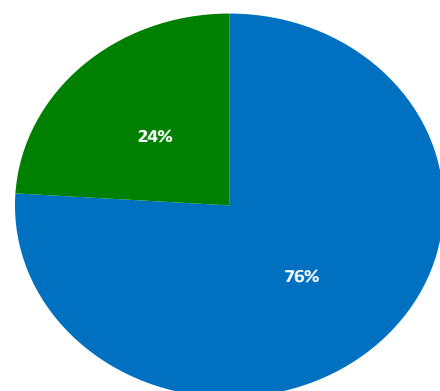

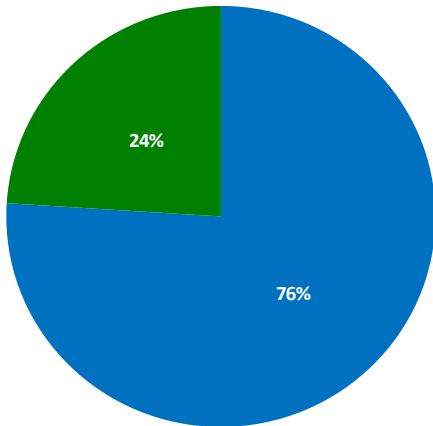
Workshop 4 - Flap Design

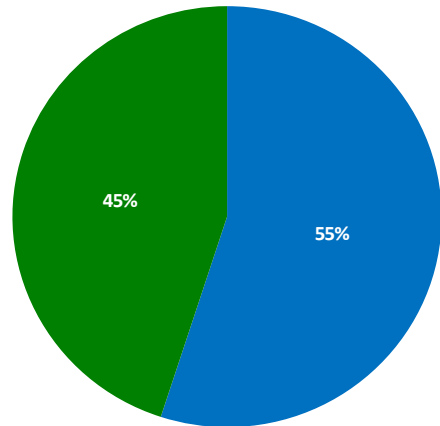

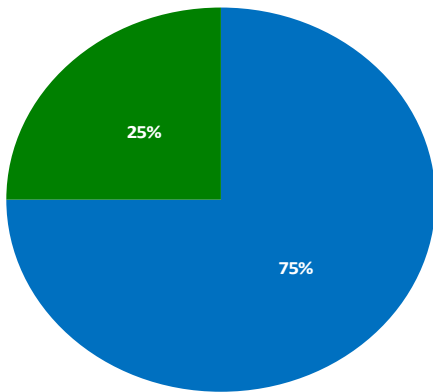

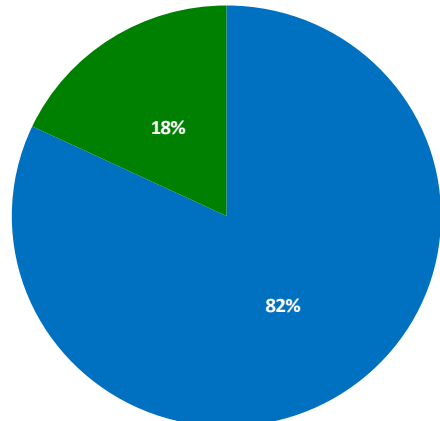

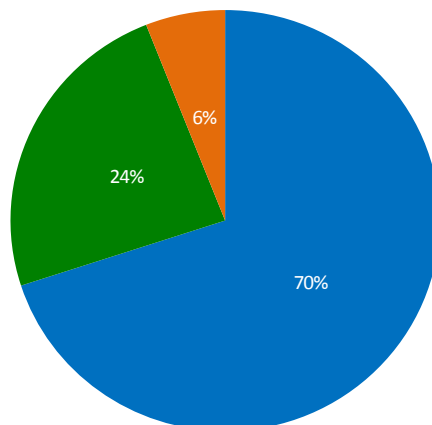
