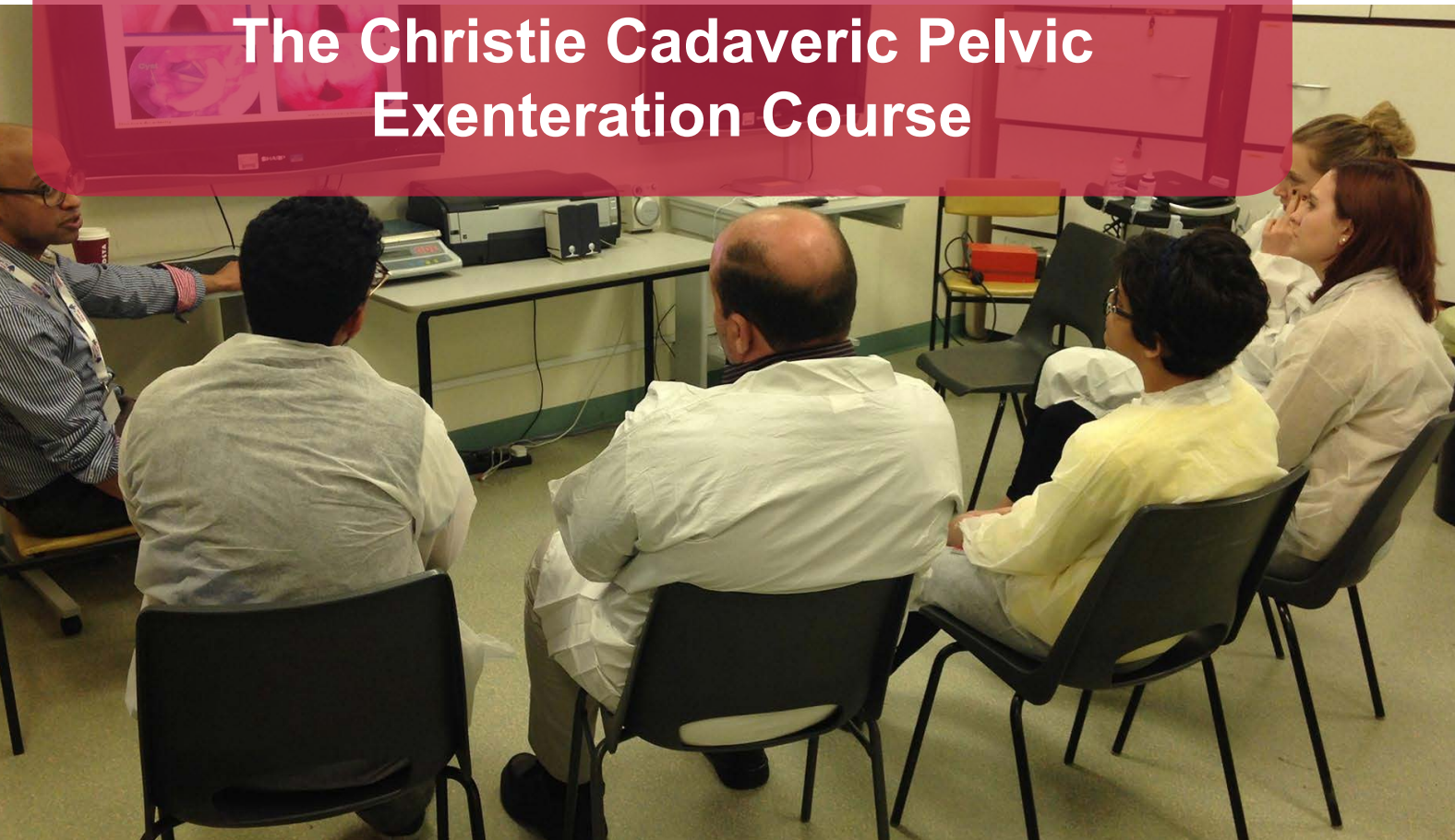


The Christie Cadaveric Pelvic Exenteration Course

The Christie Cadaveric Pelvic Exenteration Course

This highly focused and specialised hands-on cadaveric course covered the key steps and principles involved in pelvic exenteration procedures in colorectal surgery, gynecology, gynae-oncology and urology.

Taught and delivered by world experts in the field the course covered establishing the TME plane, identification and preservation of ureters, anterior and lateral mobilisation of the urinary bladder, incision through endopelvic fascia, management of dorsal vein complex, identification of side wall vasculature and sloping vessels, identification of obturator canal, extended lymphadenectomy, sacrectomy, ELAPE, omentoplasty, mesh reconstruction and flap reconstruction. In addition, the hands-on session will include liver mobilisation and ablation, diaphragm peritoneal stripping, omentectomy (greater and lesser), cholecystectomy, splenectomy, salpingo-oophorectomy, bowel resections and pelvic peritonectomy.

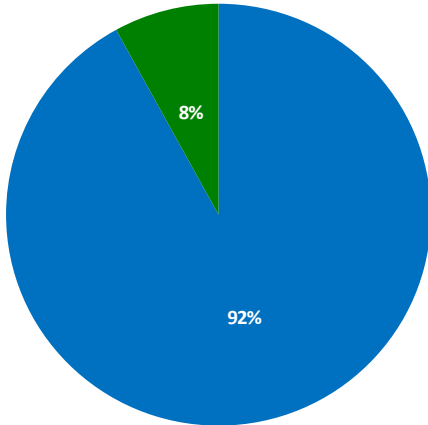

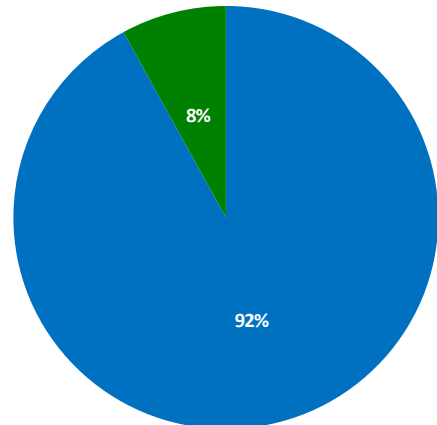

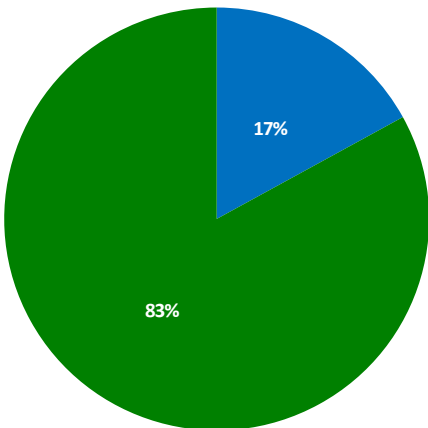

How would you rate the general academic standard of the tutors?



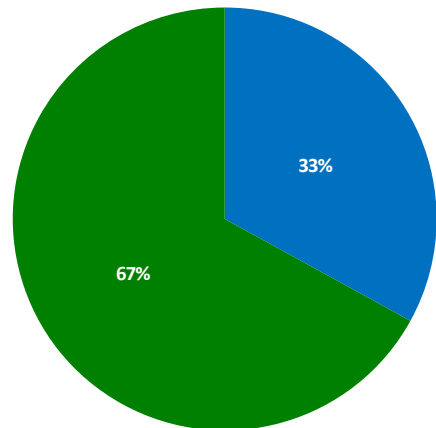

Did you have sufficient hands-on practice and time?



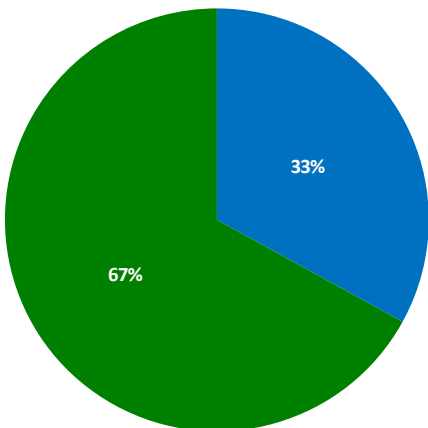

Was the tutor-delegate ratio sufficient?



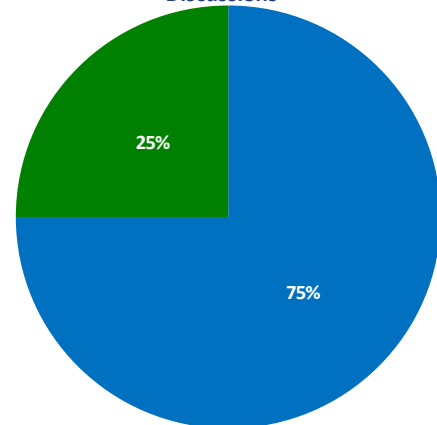

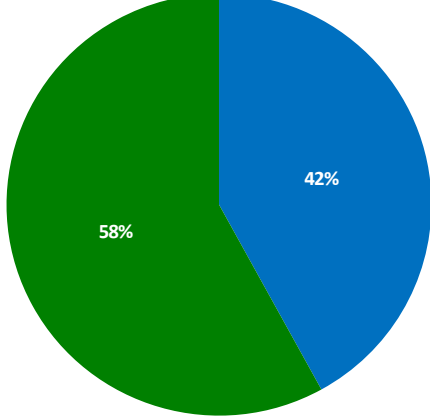
Peritoneal MDT with Focused Case Discussions

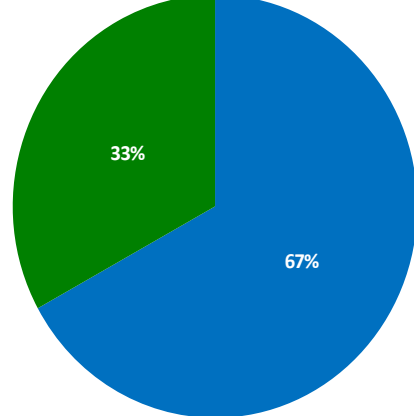

Axial and Anterior Compartments (including Hysterectomy)



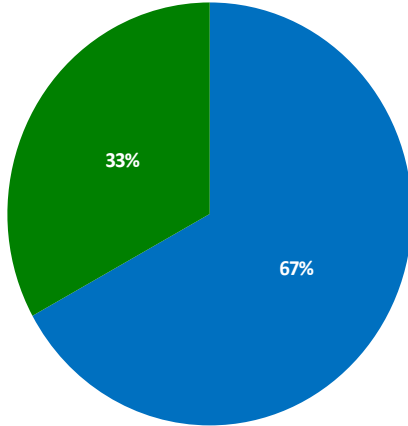

Lateral Compartment (including Lymphadenectomy)



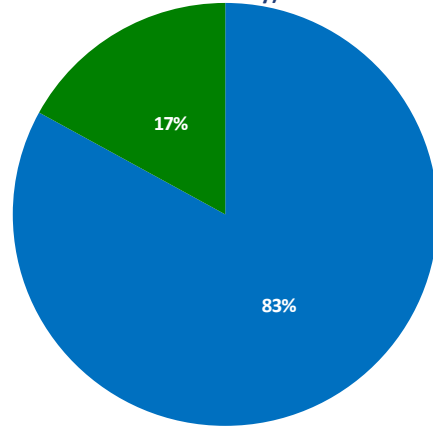

Inferior Compartment (including Perineal Urethrectomy, Interlabial Dissection, Pubic Bone)



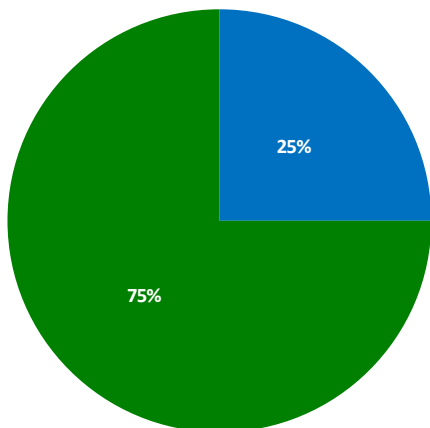

Posterior Compartment (including Sacrectomy)



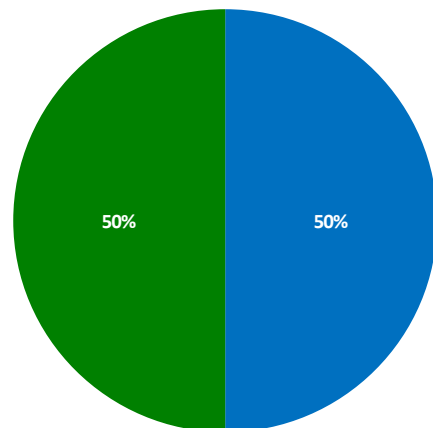

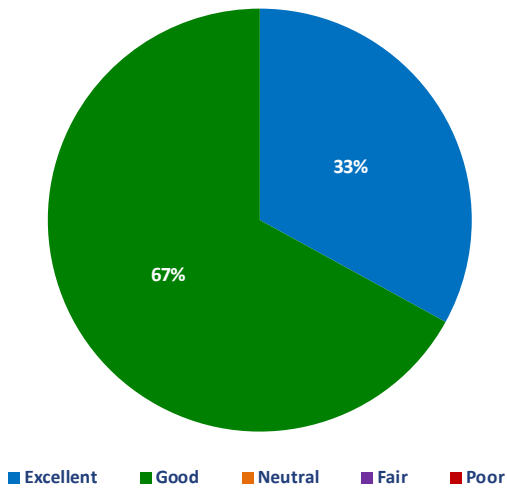

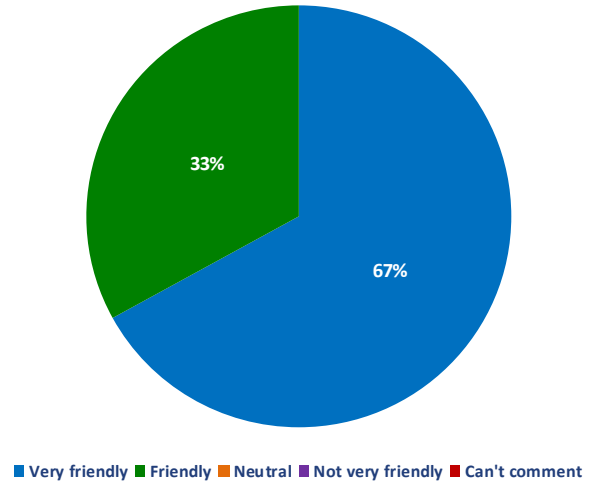

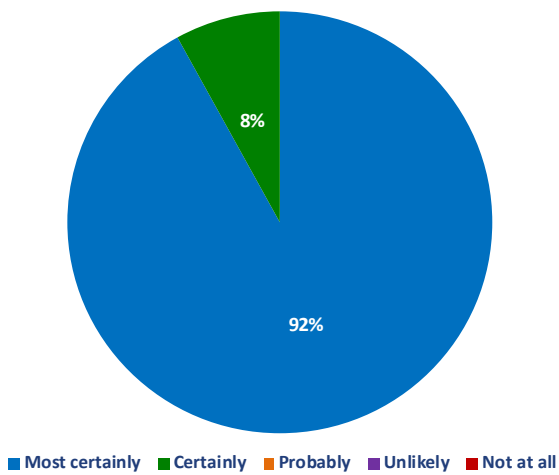

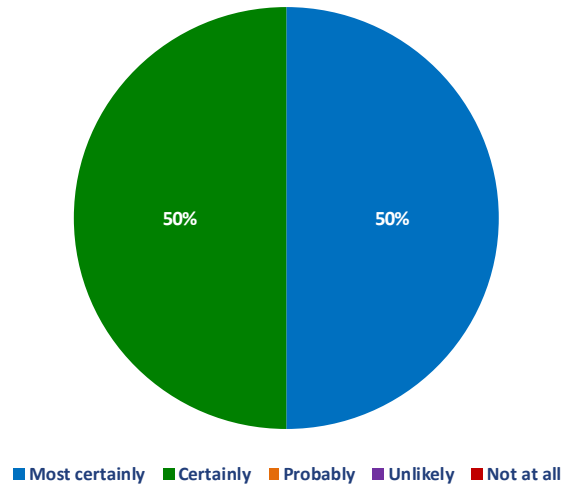

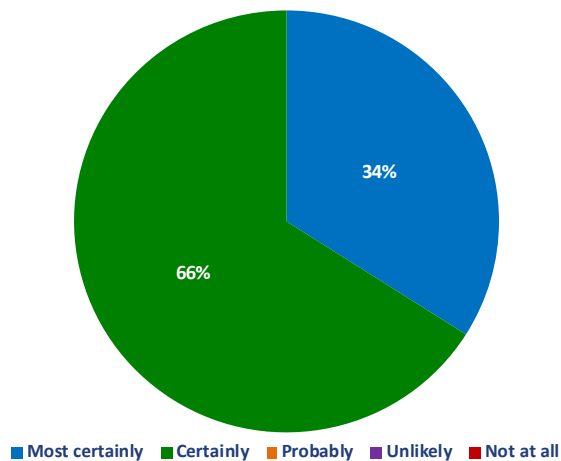
