II. DIRECTIONS AND PARKING

There are local bus services running throughout the Greater Manchester area, as well as the Metrolink tram service.

• Buses from Piccadilly Bus Station: 14, 16, 41, 42, 43, 43a, 44, 45a, 48, 111, 140, 142, 157, 250.

- Buses from Oxford Road Station: All buses that run along Oxford Road.
- Buses from Cross Street (outside Boots the Chemist): 47, 87, 50, 143, 197, 291.
- Buses from Manchester Airport: 43a, 45a.
- Bus from Piccadilly Train Station: 147.
- Bus from Victoria Station: 42.
- Bus from Shudehill Interchange: 18.
- Tram: Alight at St Peter's Square and walk or catch a bus down Oxford Road.

If you are travelling by train to Piccadilly Rail Station, you can take the Oxford Road link bus (number 147) to Grafton Street. This service runs between 0715 and 1845 hours at ten-minute intervals, and it can be caught from the Fairfield Street entrance to Piccadilly Station. Alternatively, you can take a taxi from Piccadilly Station to the venue (approx. \pounds 6).

Parking:

The closest car parks are Grafton Street and Cecil Street. Please note that standard charges apply.
