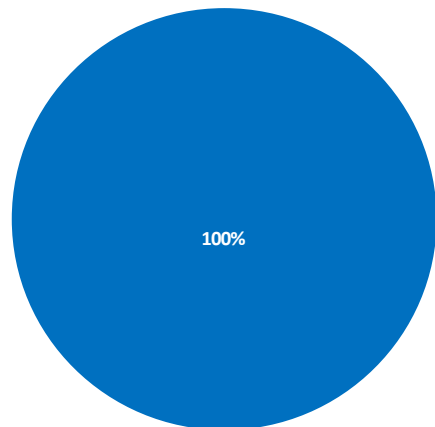

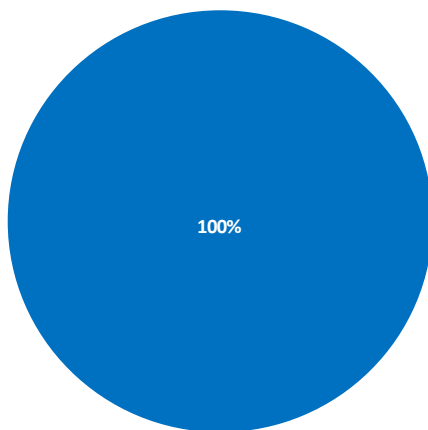

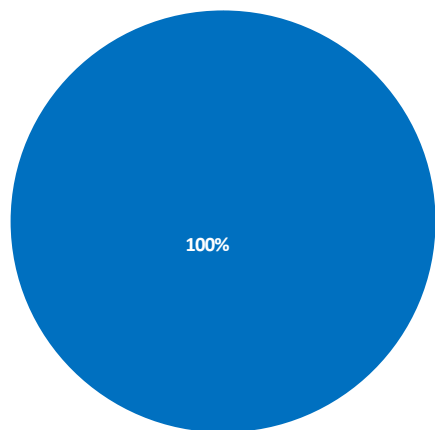

Anatomy of the Face



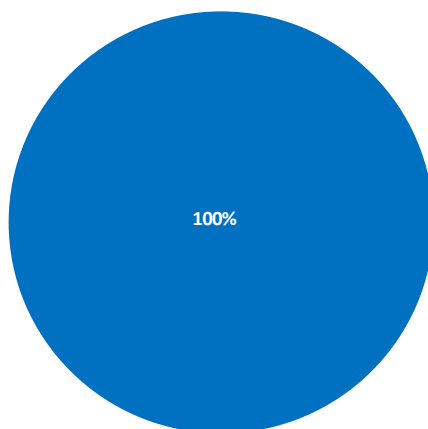

Anatomy of the Neck



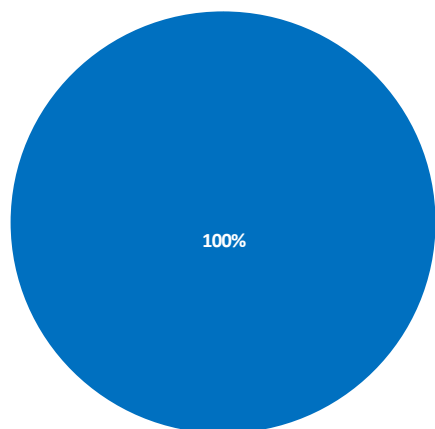

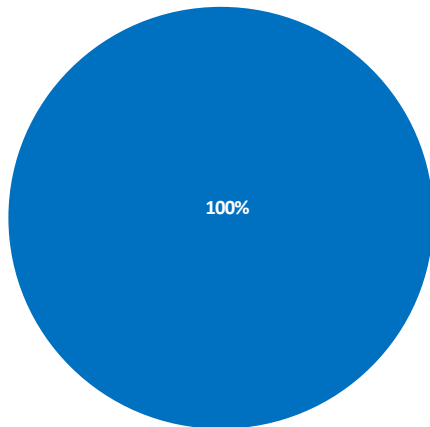

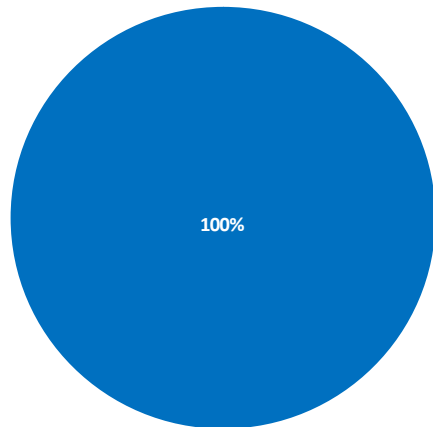

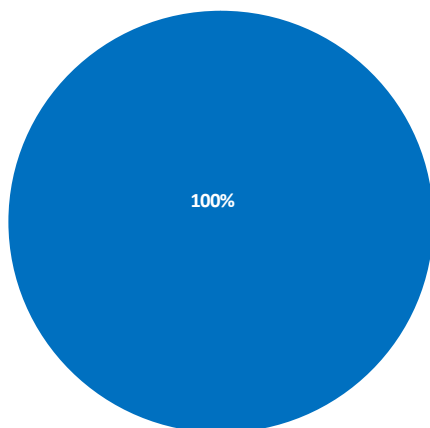

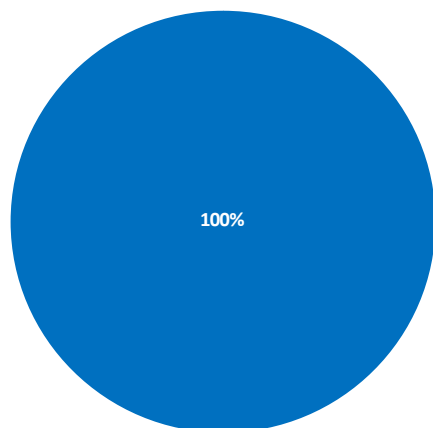

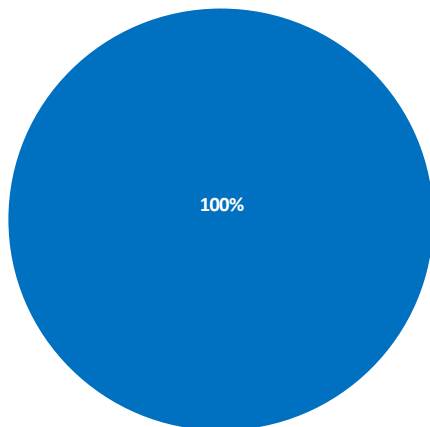

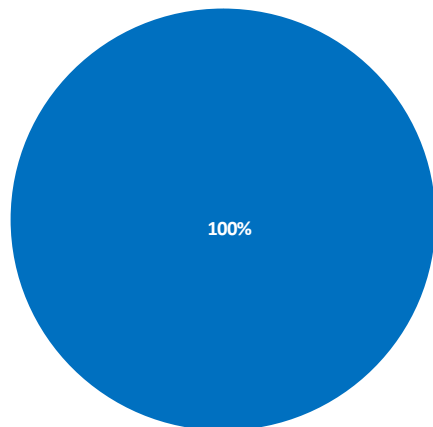

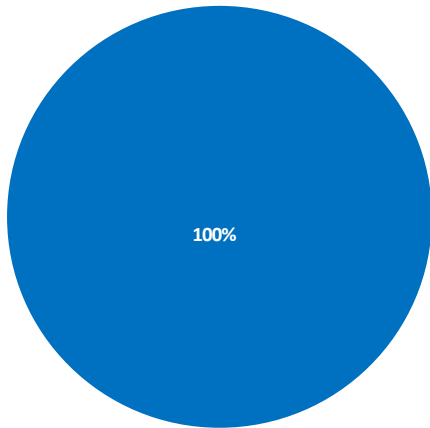
Vestibular System

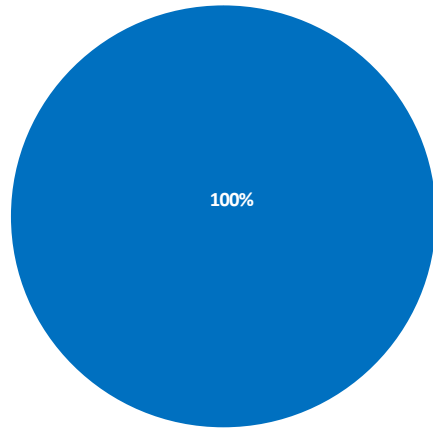

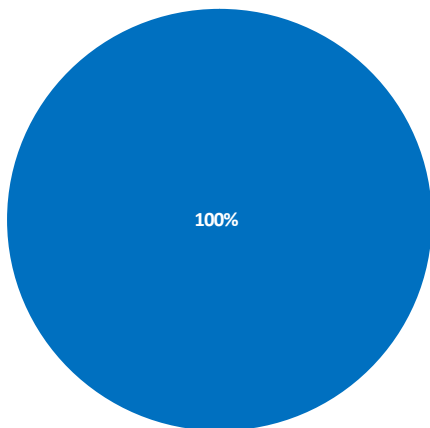

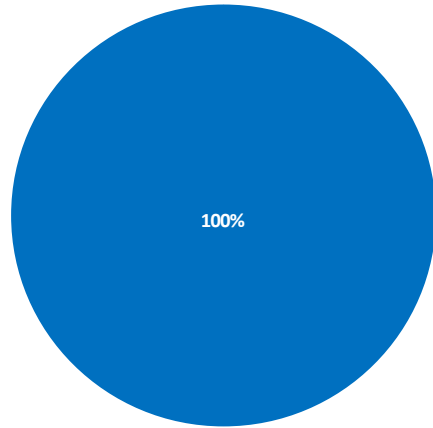

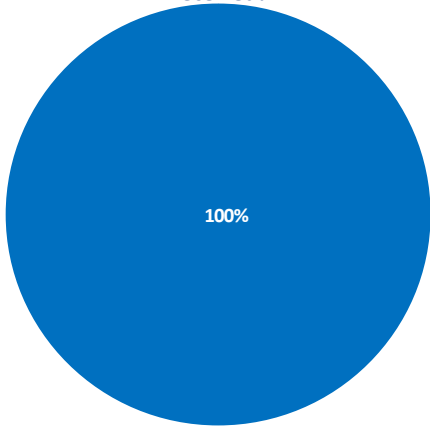

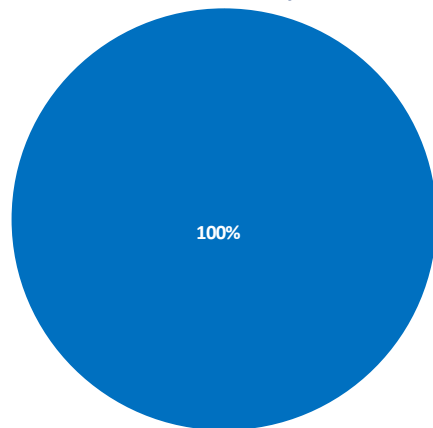

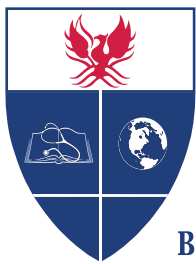
