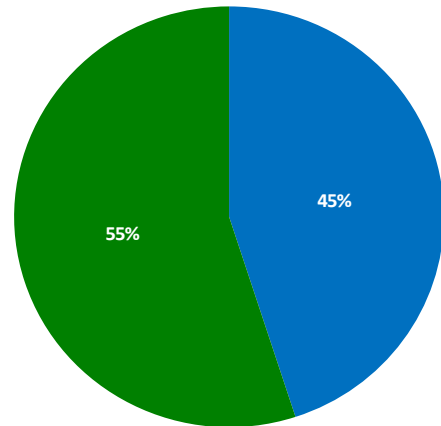

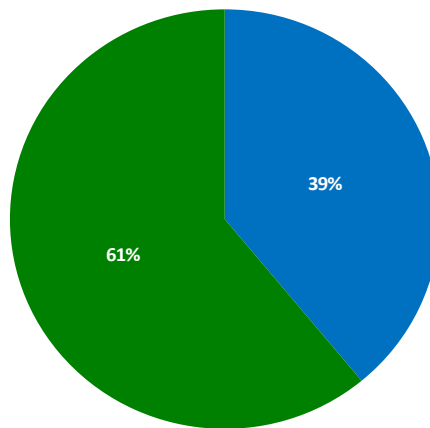

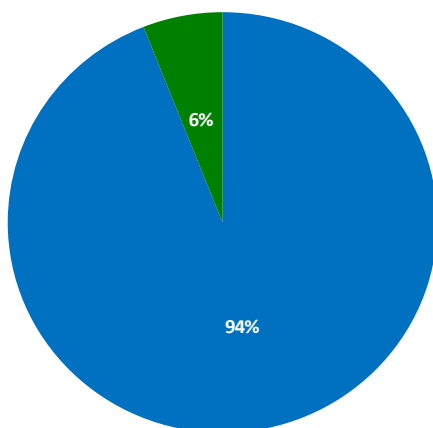

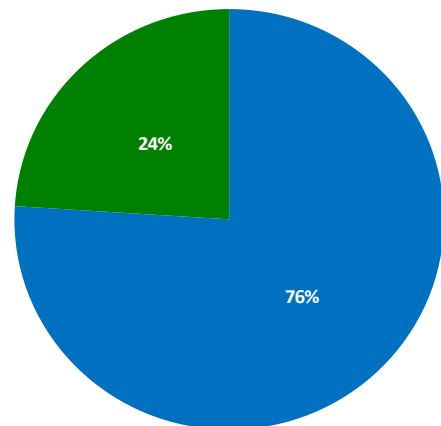

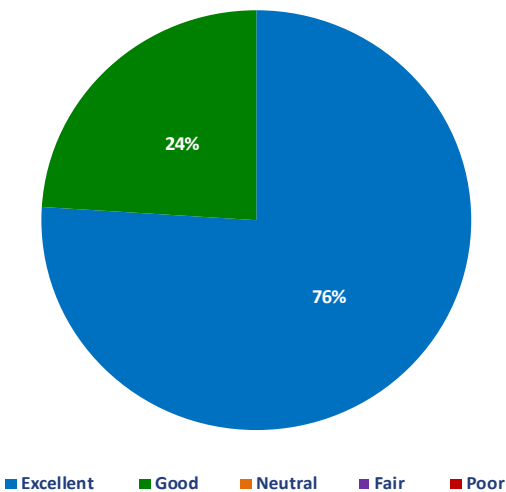

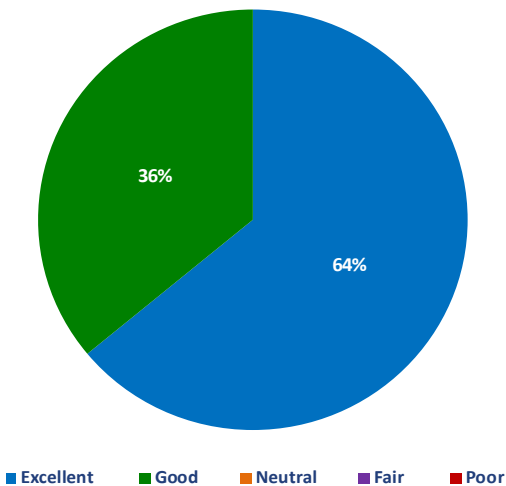


The duration of the station.

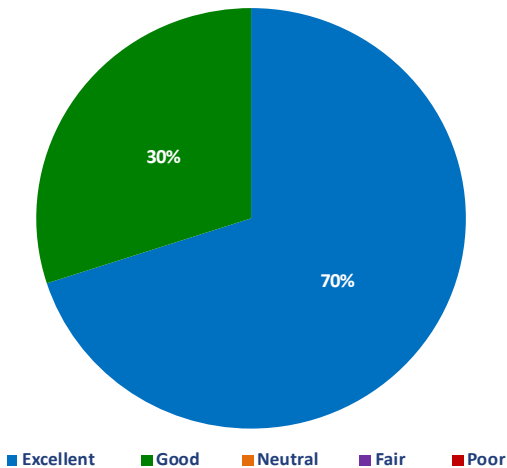

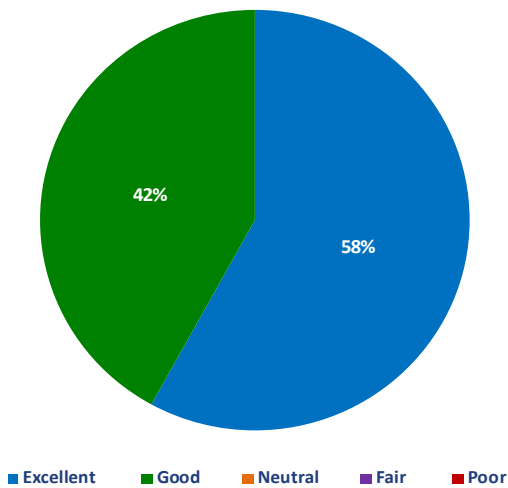

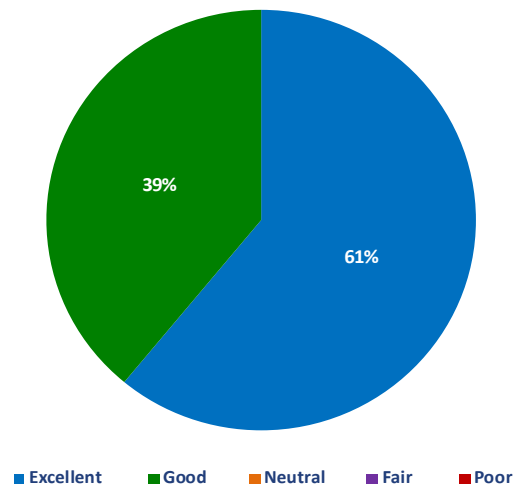

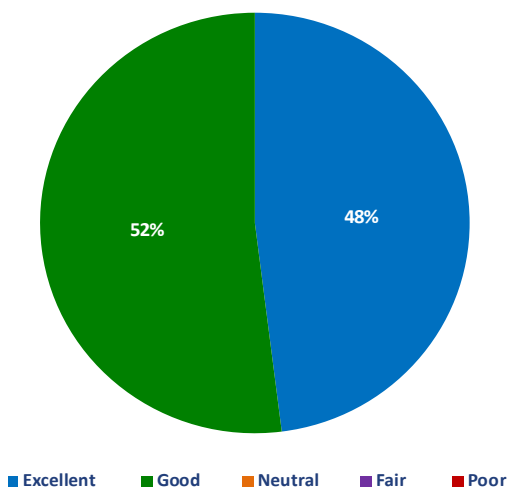

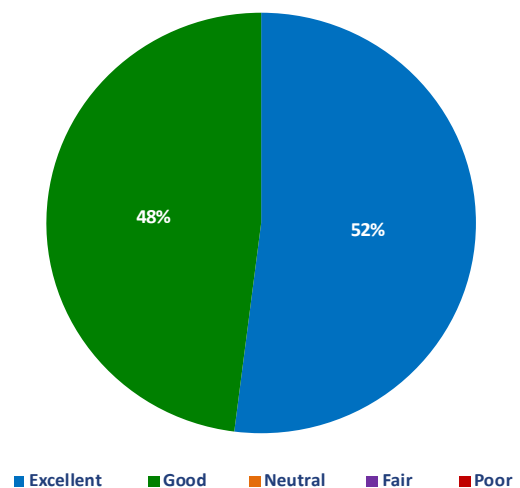


Mini Surgical Skills Competition

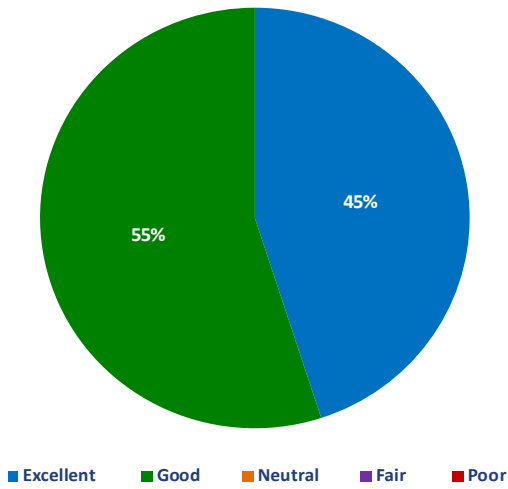

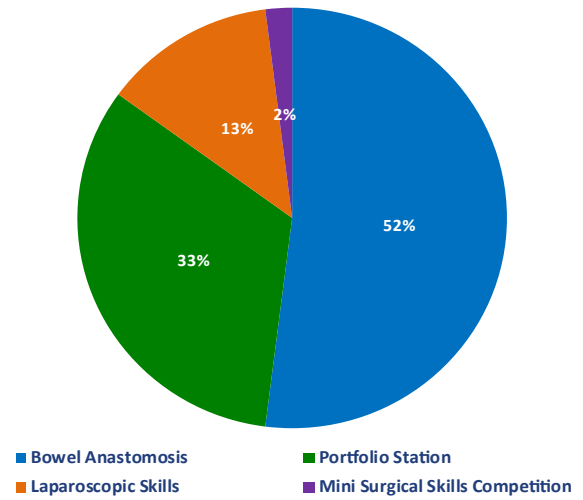

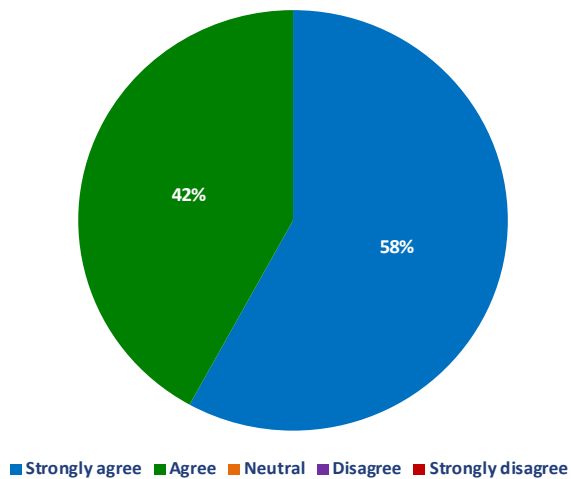


What was the most useful station/your favourite station?

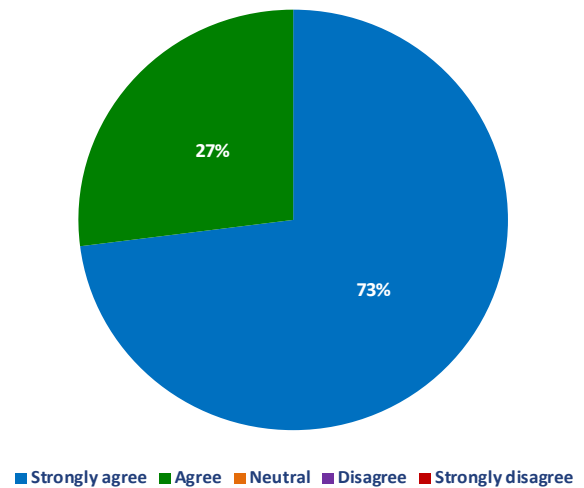

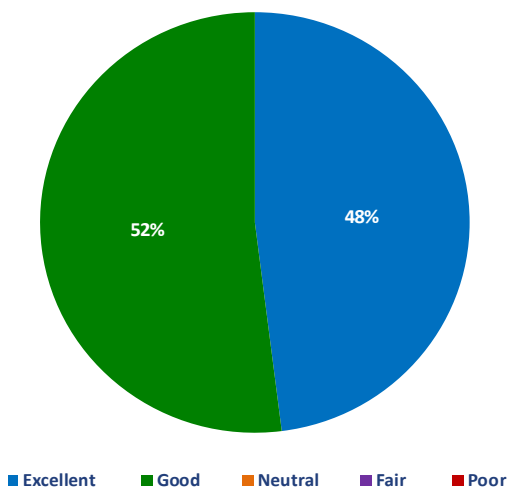

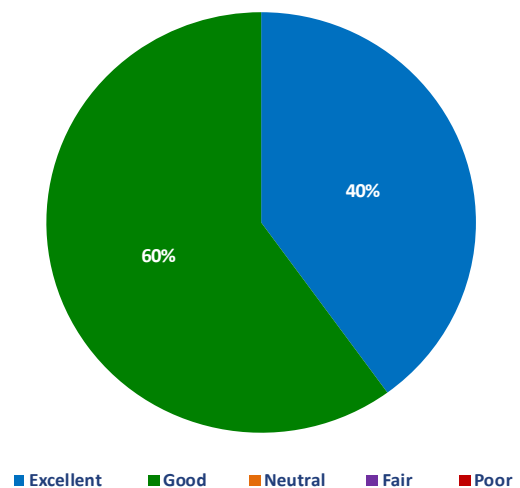

How were the facilities and venue?

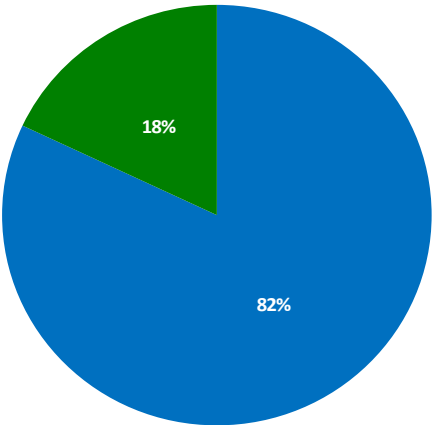

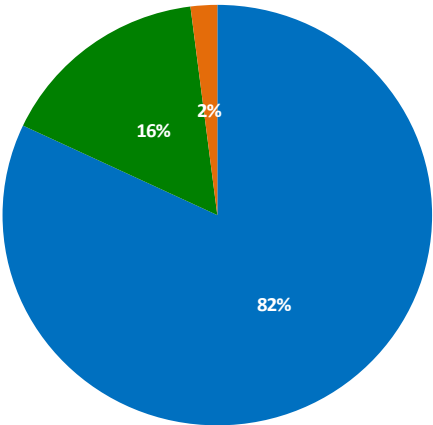
