Fundamental Principles of Microsurgical Anastomosis, Flap Designs and Tendon Repairs

This hybrid course discussed the fundamental principles of microsurgical anastomosis, flap designs and tendon repairs. The theoretical component of the course was delivered via Zoom on Wednesday 10th July 2024 (1800-2100 hours), and the practical component took place at the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Cardiff, Cardiff Bay on Tuesday 16th July 2024 (0830-1800 hours).

Delegates used mounted simulators to practise the basics of microsurgery. They performed microsurgical repairs of nerves and vessels using animal models. They also performed local flaps and Z-plasty on animal models, as well as tendon repairs.


