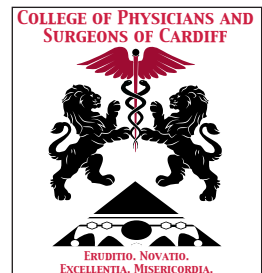

Cardiff MRCS Course: Intensive Preparatory Course for MRCS OSCE

This two-day intensive preparatory course was specifically designed for candidates appearing for the MRCS exam in July 2021. The course primarily focussed on practice of hands-on practical skills, clinical examination skills, and communication skills. In addition, there were small group sessions (question and answer format) of the core knowledge areas tested in the exam, although there was no teaching on these topics.

This attendance course was delivered to a small group of delegates and complied with the Health Authority and Government guidelines for social distancing and other appropriate measures.

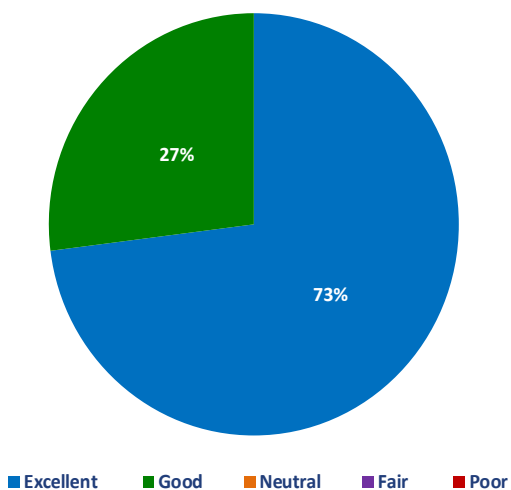

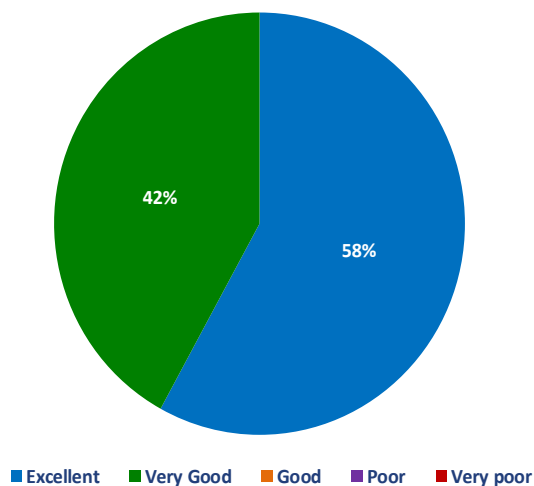

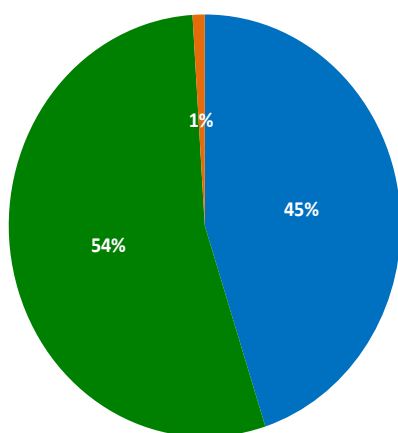

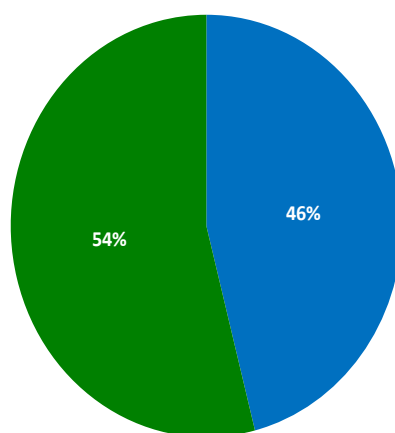

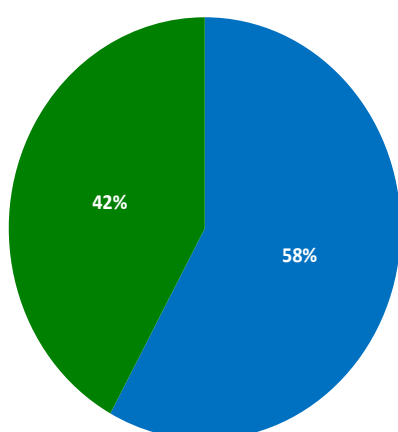

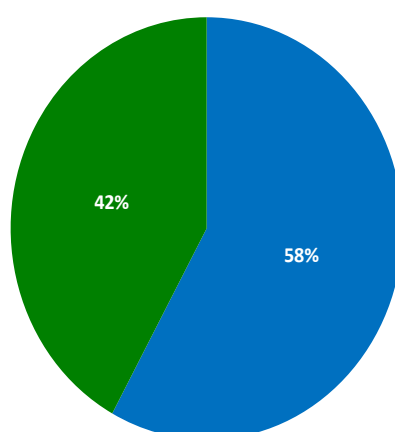

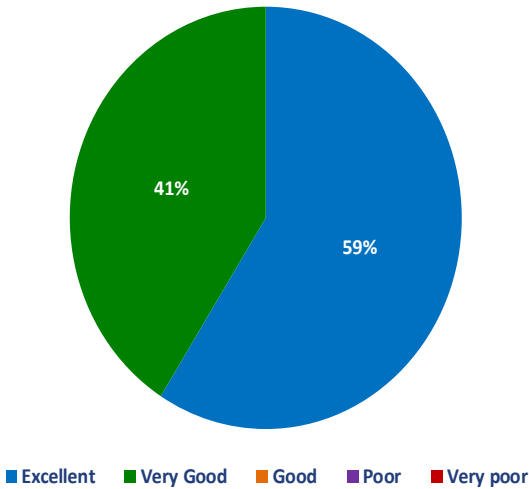

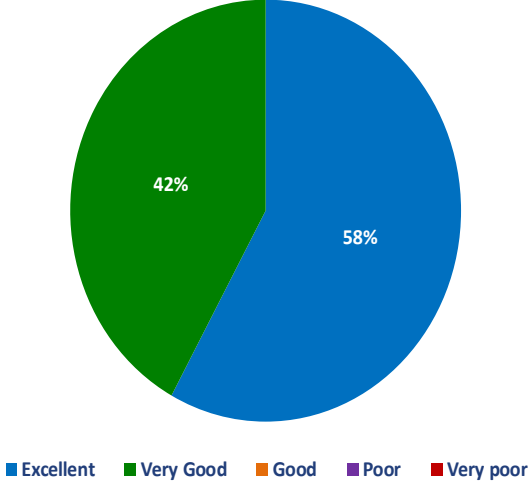

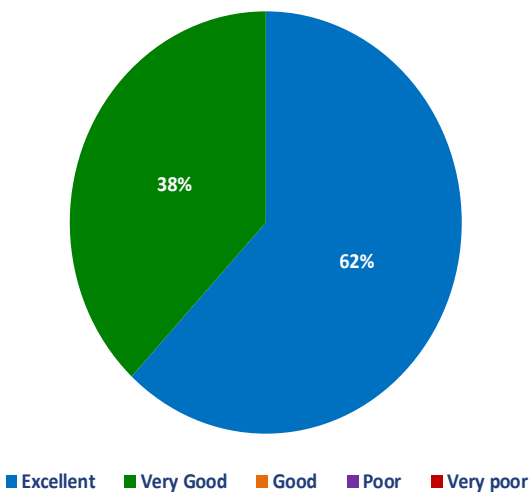

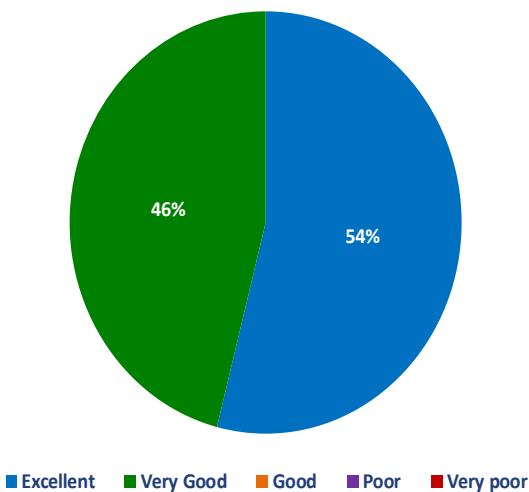
Communication Skills –Delayed Diagnosis (Carcinoid)



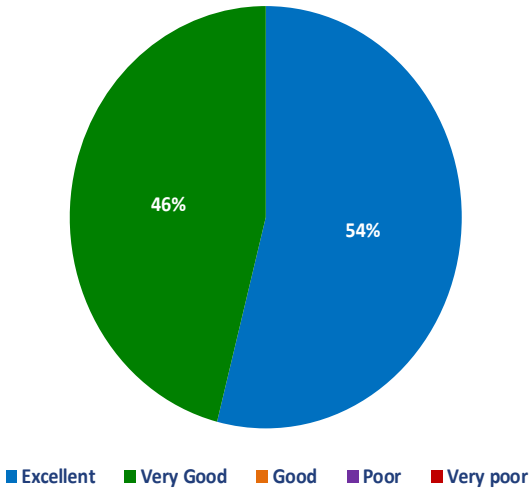

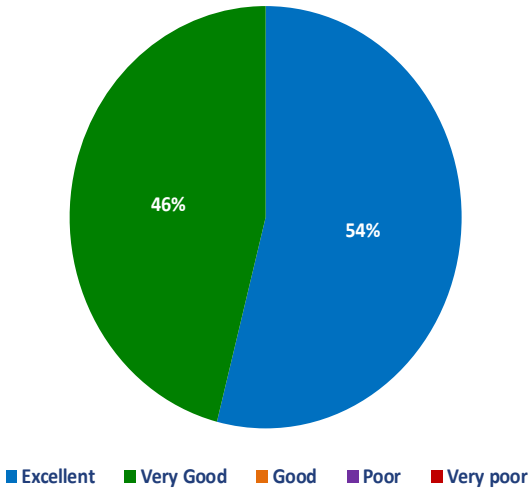
