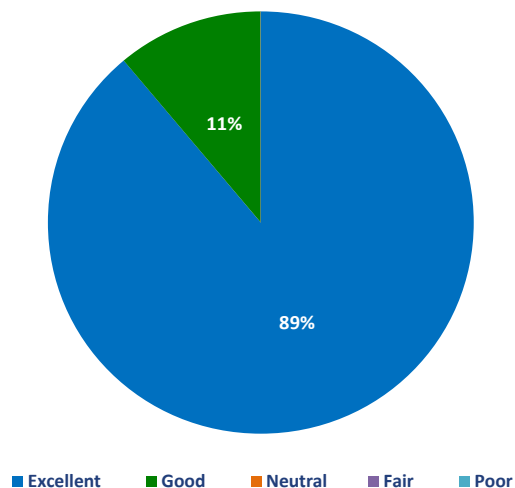

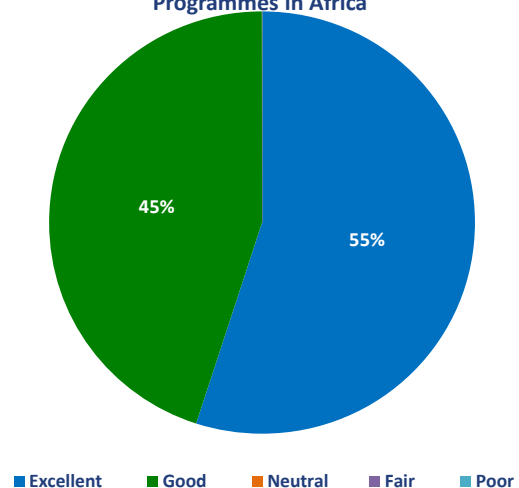
How would you rate the general academic standard of the speakers?



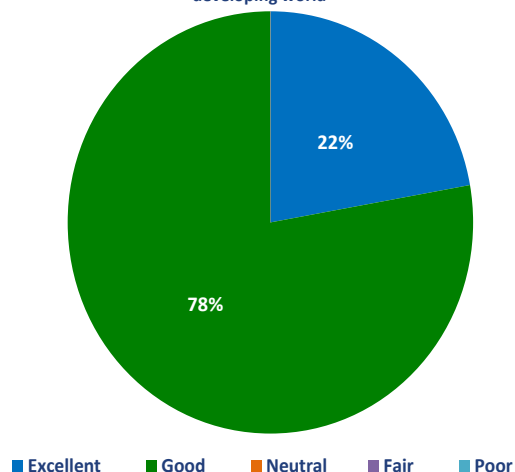

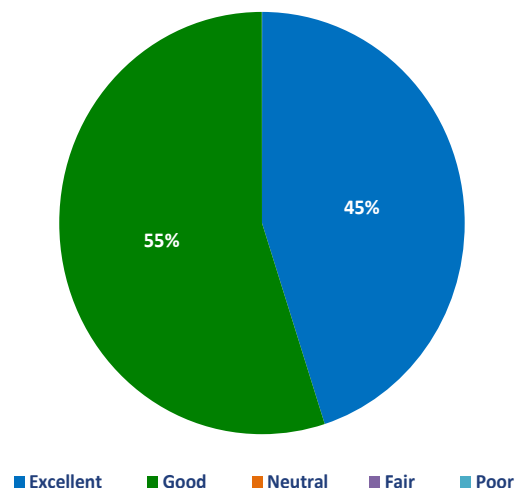

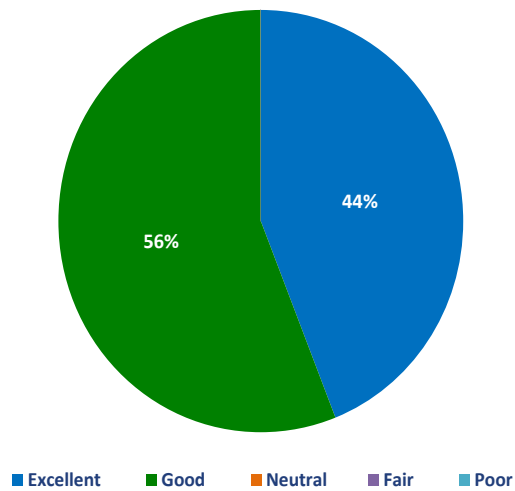


Skills, One extended skill, to choose from: Advanced Suturing

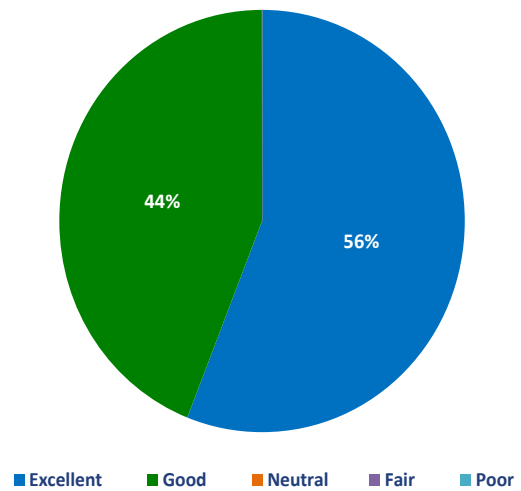

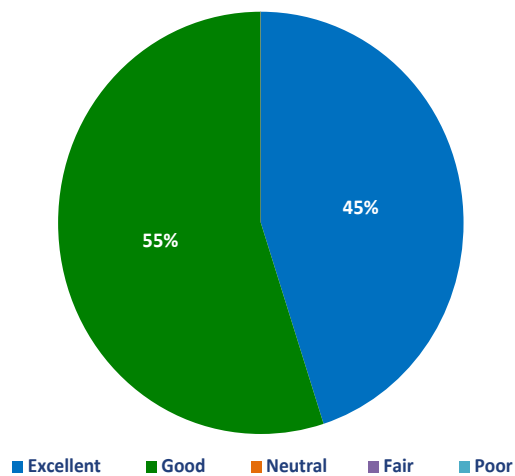

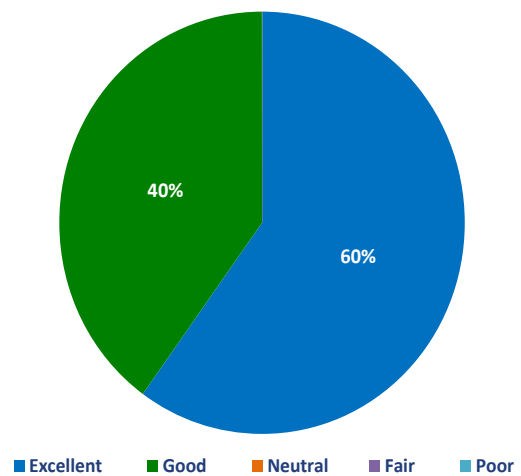

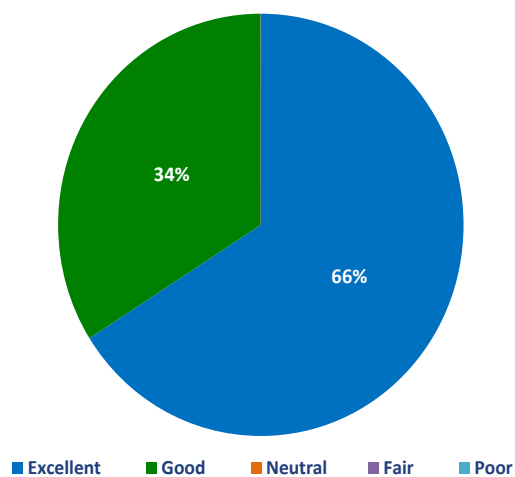

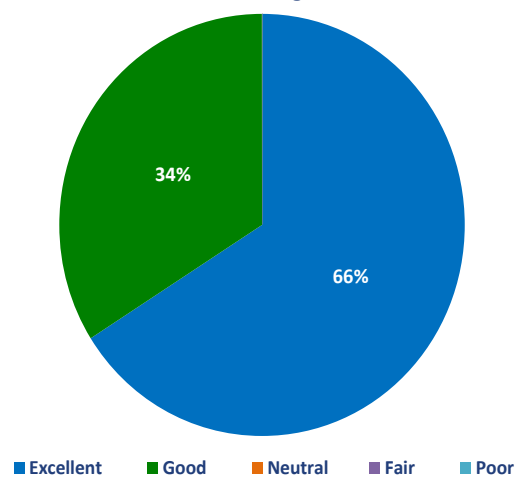

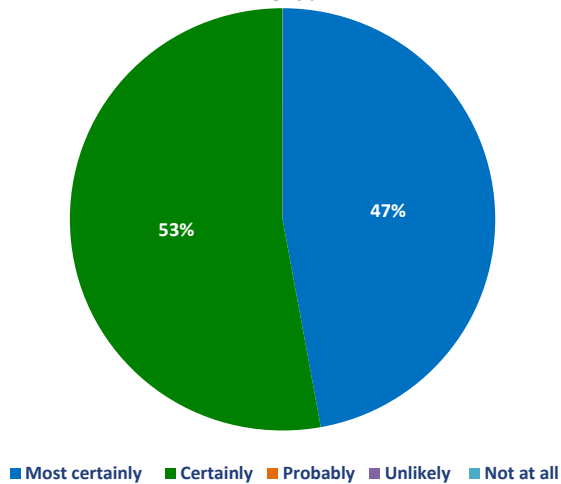

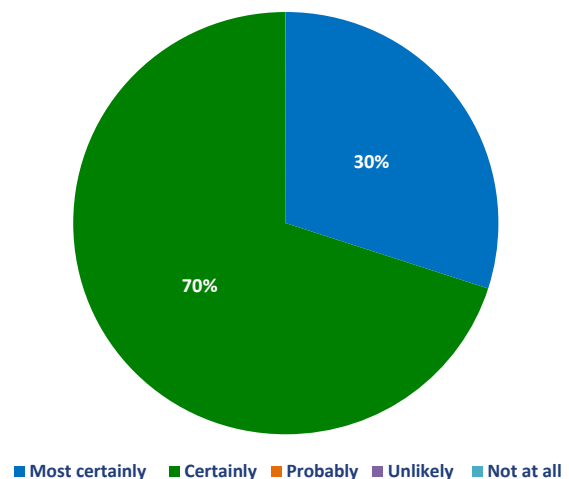
