2nd Year Head and Neck Revision Evening

The first half of the two-hour revision evening was dedicated to neuroanatomy and head and neck anatomy. This was presented by Miss Sharon Chandrakanth (vice president of GUBES society and fourth year medical student at the University of Glasgow).

The second half of the session focussed on revision of 'Head and Neck' neurophysiology, covering key topics, such as, functioning of cerebral lobes, brainstem and the spinal pathways. 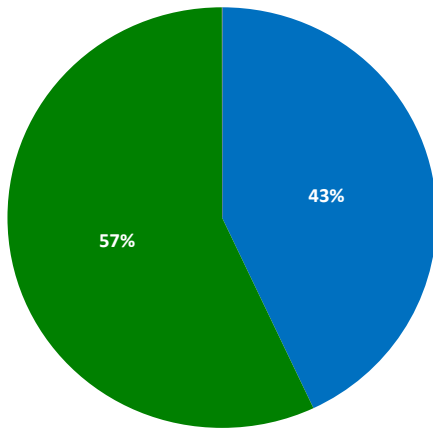

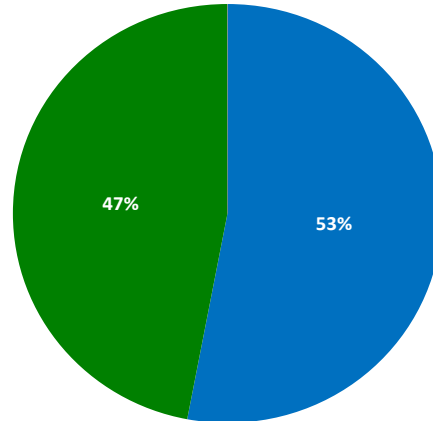

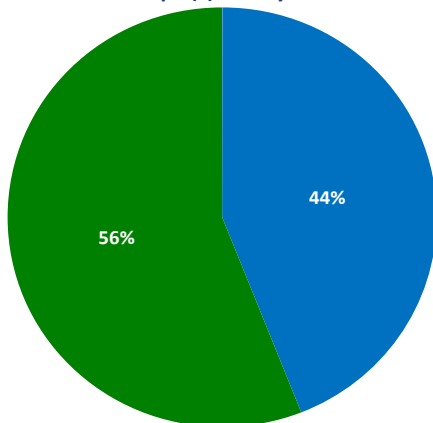

H&N Anatomy Lecture: Sharon Chandrakanth: Was the lecture delivered well?



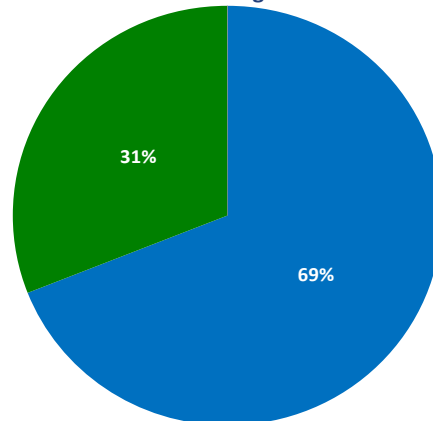

H&N Anatomy Lecture: Sharon Chandrakanth: Did the lecture explain the topic(s) clearly?



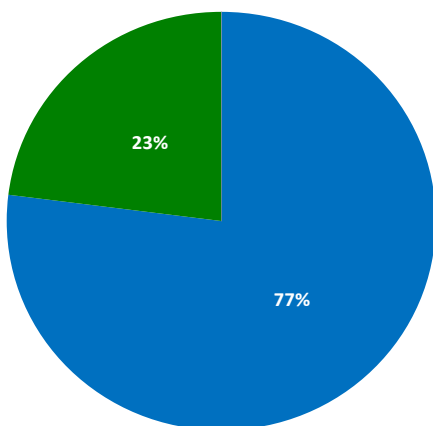

H&N Anatomy Lecture: Sharon Chandrakanth: Where the contents of the lecture well organised?



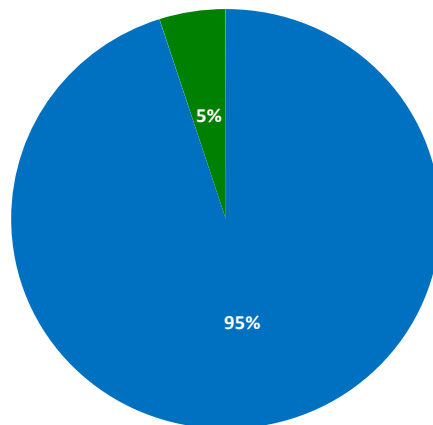

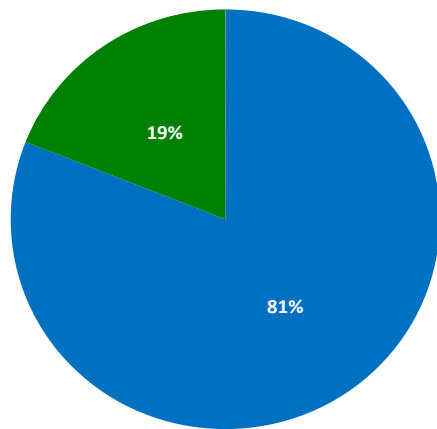

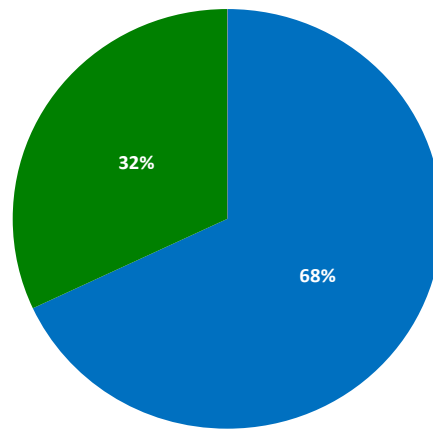
