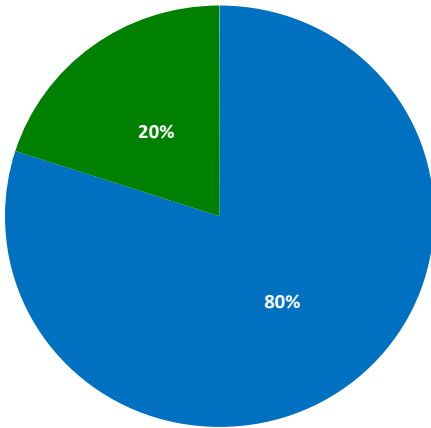

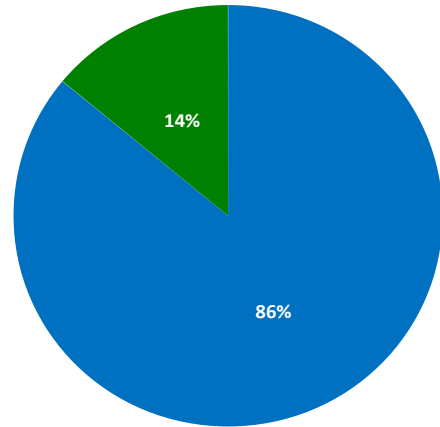

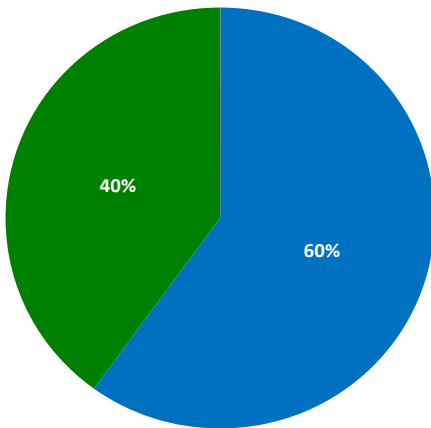

How would you rate the general academic standard of the speakers?



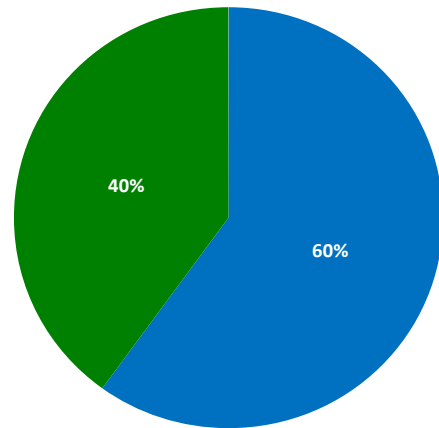

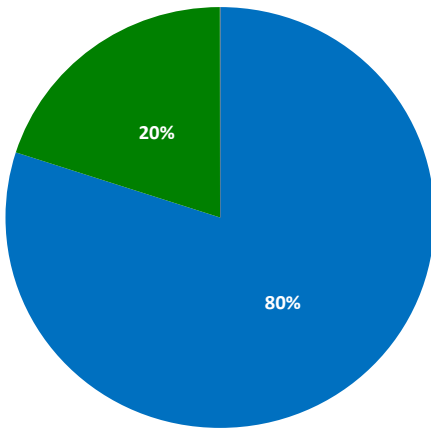

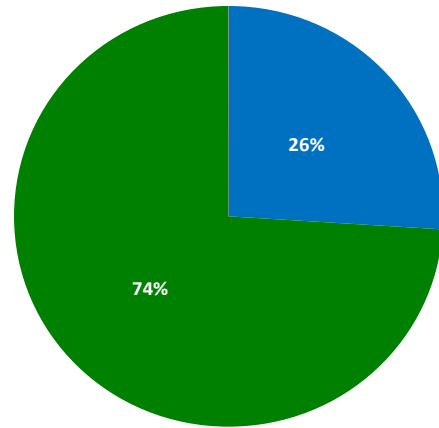

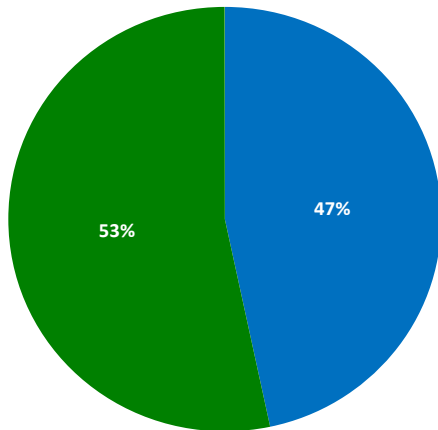

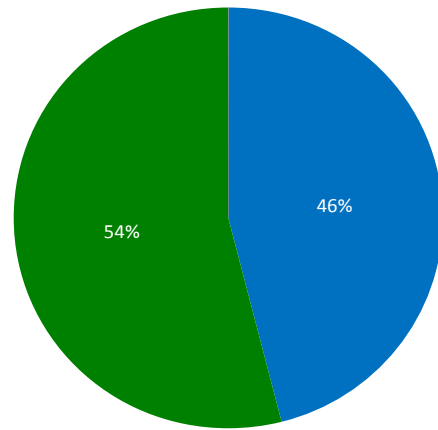

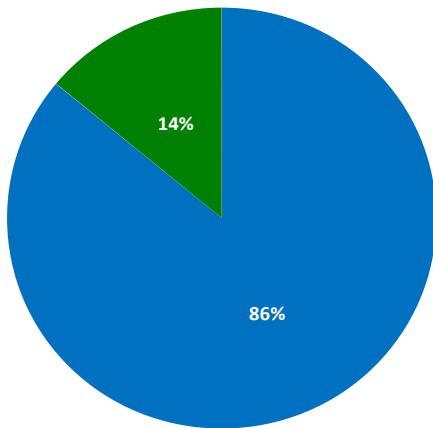

Surgical skills workshop - Hand tying & suturing



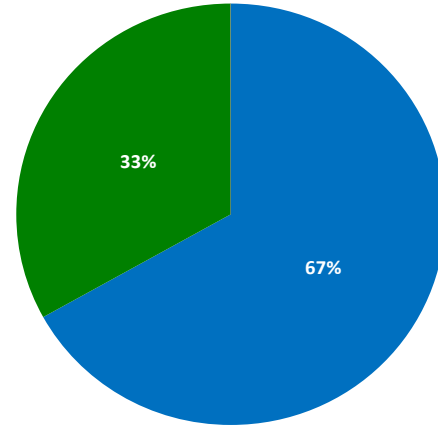

Surgical skills workshop - Laparoscopy simulation



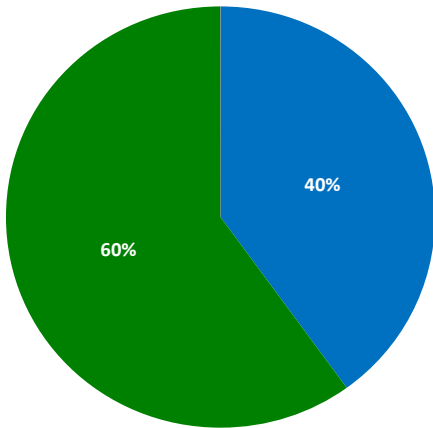

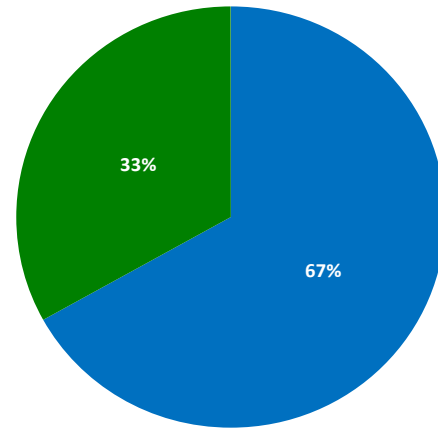

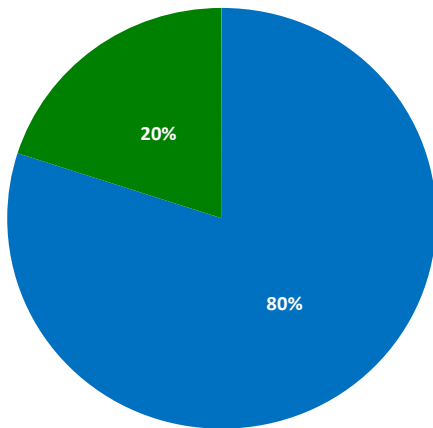

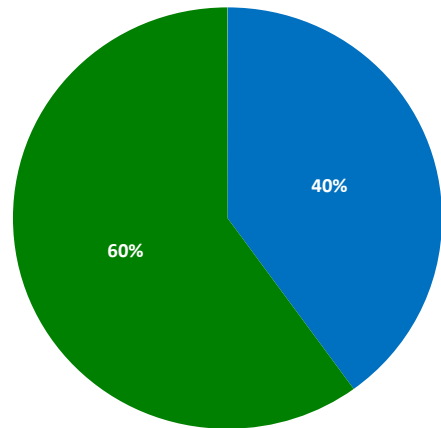

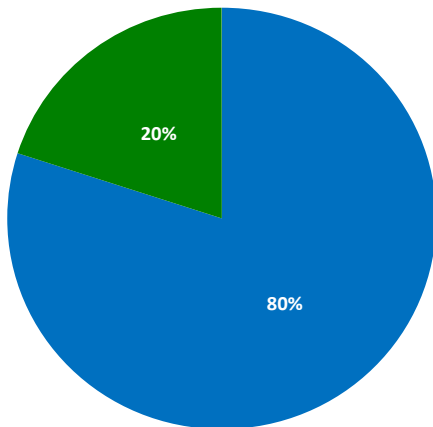

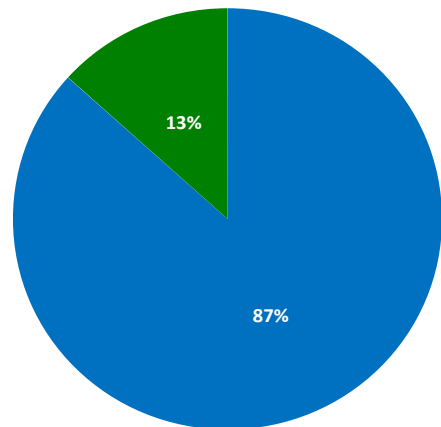

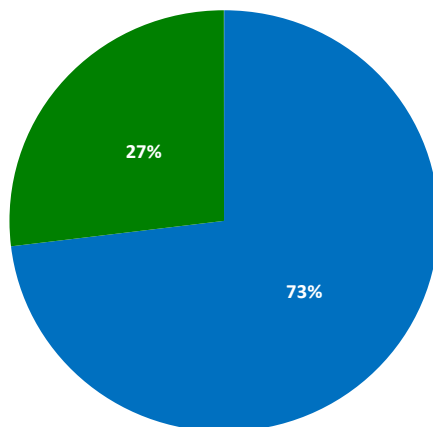
