The Hull and York Surgical Societies' National Surgical Conference is the flagship annual event organised collaboratively by York Surgical Society and Hull Surgical Society. This one-day national student conference featured several keynote talks from consultant surgeons on a variety of topics within the field of surgery. The keynote speakers invited were national and international leaders in their respective surgical fields.

The 2022 conference was "Surgery Beyond Borders" and discussed topics including global surgery, international humanitarian missions, improvement and education of underdeveloped healthcare systems, interesting complex surgeries performed in underserved areas globally, perspective on training abroad, and military trauma surgery.

The conference included a series of hands-on practical workshops teaching a variety of essential surgical skills and covering a wide range of surgical specialties and surgical interests.

This academic meeting also offered delegates the opportunity to present research projects as well as the opportunity to network with like-minded colleagues, surgical trainees and consultant surgeons.




Basic Suturing




Advanced Suturing











### Cyst/Nipple excision (Plastic Surgery)











Vascular Anastomoses





How were the facilities and venue?








