The Hull and York Surgical Societies' 10th National Surgical Conference was the flagship annual event organised collaboratively by York Surgical Society and Hull Surgical Society.

This one-day national student conference featured several keynote talks from consultant surgeons on a variety of topics within the field of surgery. The keynote speakers invited were national and international leaders in their respective surgical fields.

This year's conference theme was "Innovating Surgery Around the Globe" and discussed a variety of topics.

The conference included a series of hands-on practical workshops teaching a variety of essential surgical skills and covering a wide range of surgical specialties and surgical interests.

The workshops included Basic Suturing Skills, Knot Tying, Orthopaedic Workshop, Tendon Repair, Local Flaps, Vascular Anastomosis, CV/Surgical Portfolio, Laparoscopic Surgery Skills, Chest Drain Insertion, Interventional Radiology, and Neurosurgical Skills.

This academic meeting also offered delegates the opportunity to present research projects as well as the opportunity to network with like-minded colleagues, surgical trainees and consultant surgeons.
