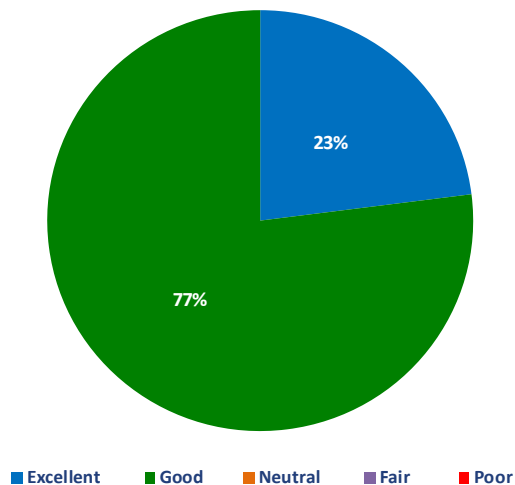

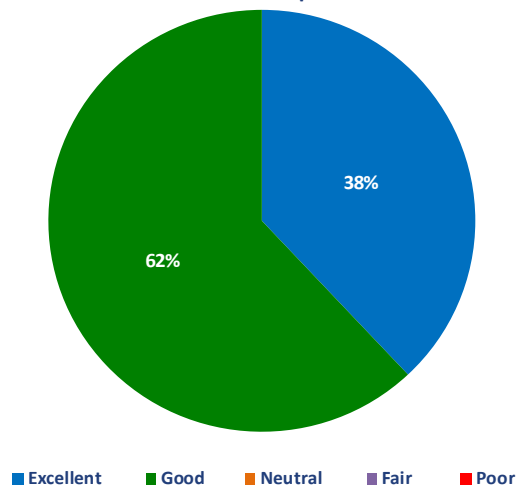

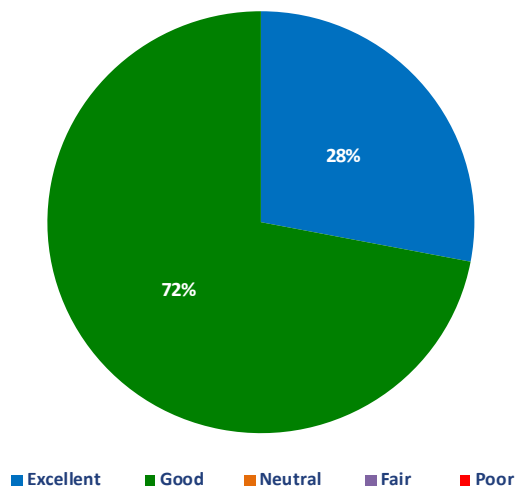
How was the content of the conference?



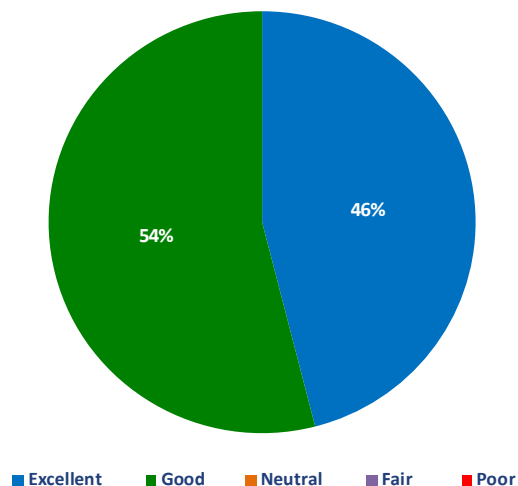
How would you rate the general academic standard of the speakers?



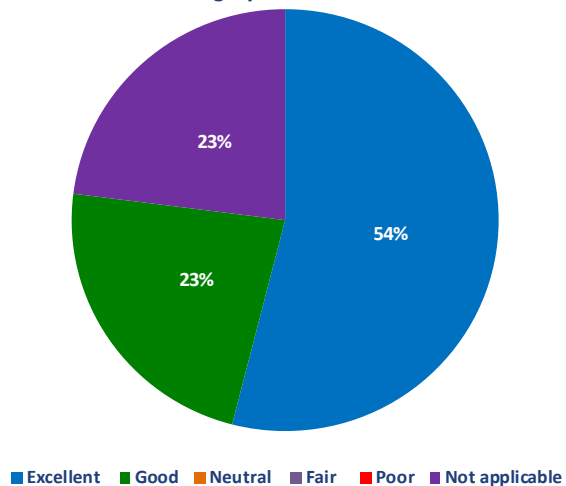

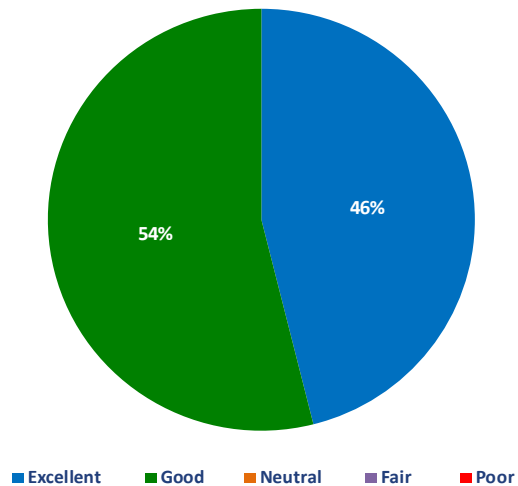

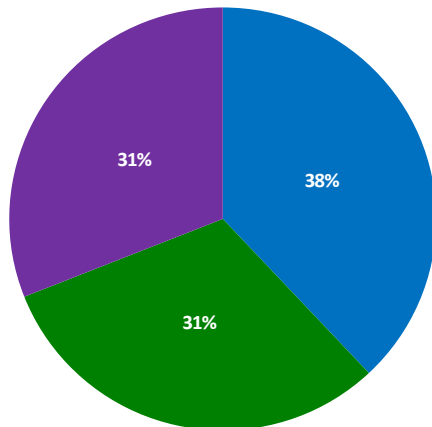


Workshop: How to Give a Winning Oral Presentation



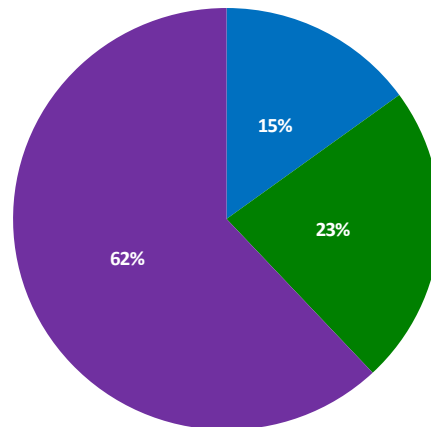

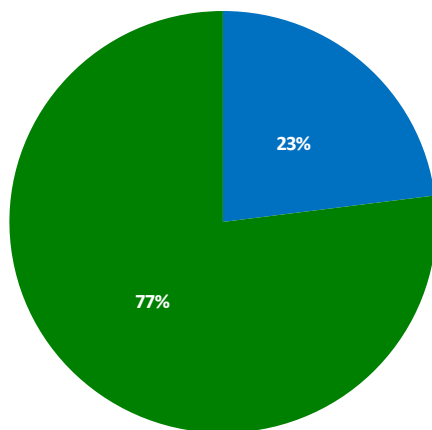

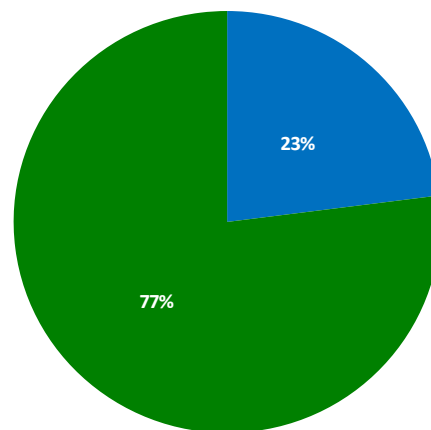

How were the facilities and venue?



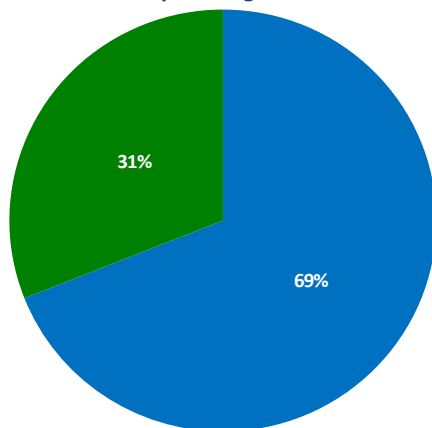

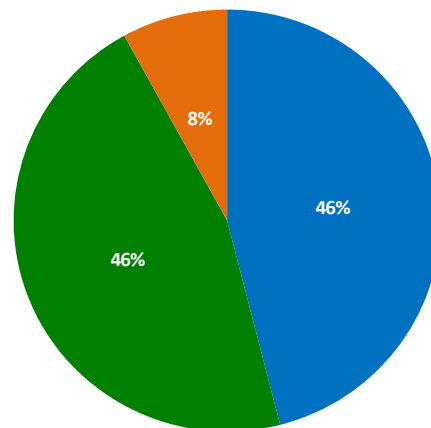

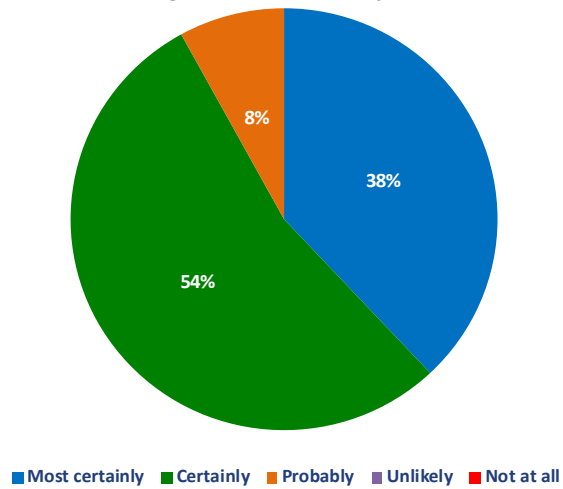
