



The Inaugural South West Plastic Surgery Conference 2018



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The Inaugural South West Plastic Surgery Conference 2018 provided attendees with an insight into the field of Plastic Surgery. The morning consisted of a series of lectures, delivered by experienced Plastic Surgeons, which explored the speciality and its sub-specialities, as well as providing practical tips on how to enter one of the most competitive surgical specialities. The afternoon session comprised of practical workshops which focused on skills commonly used by Plastic Surgeons. The workshops included basic suturing skills and knot-tying, flap design, and tendon repair.

Students had the opportunity to present a poster at the conference. Abstracts were accepted in the following areas: audit; SSU/SSC; case report; elective research project; other research project associated with Plastic Surgery (including hand surgery, dermatological surgery or surgery in general).
