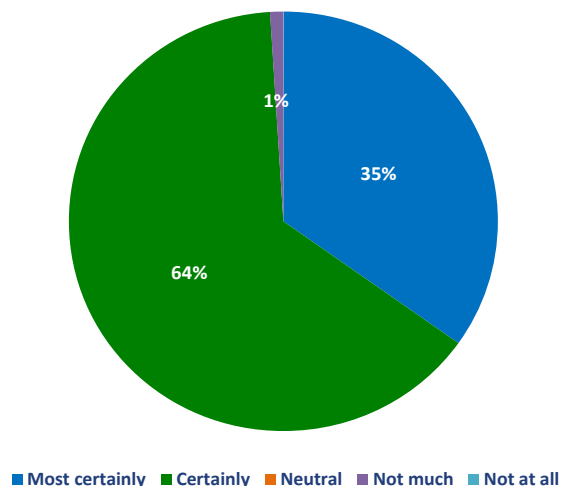

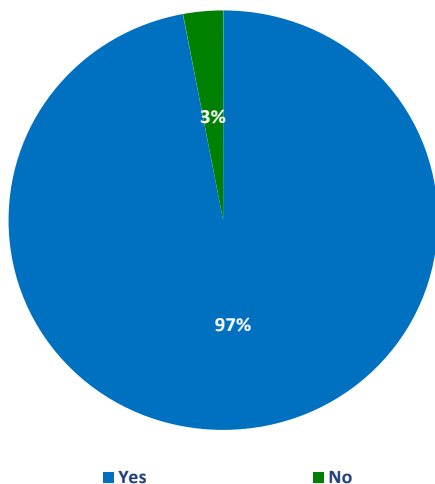

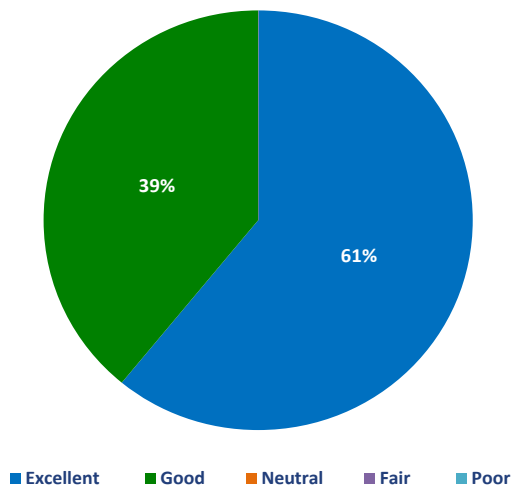

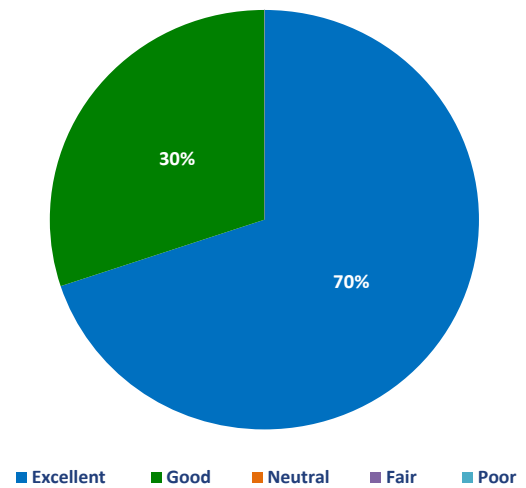

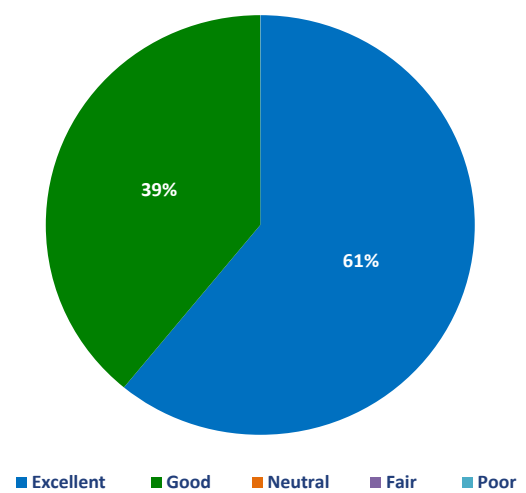
Tendon Repair



Ankle Plate Fixation

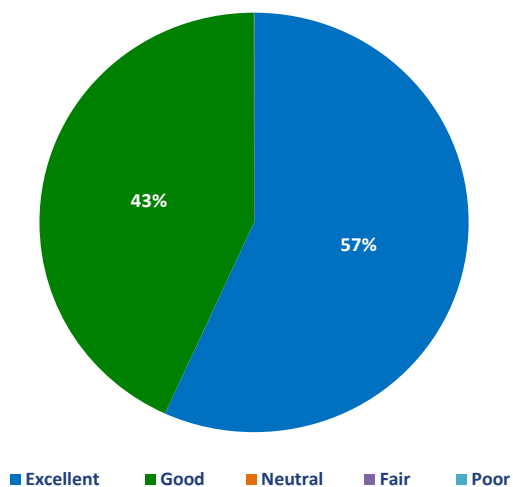

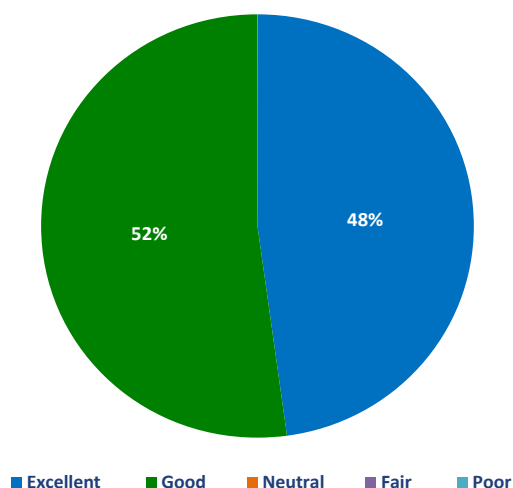

How I got into Orthopaedics: CST 1, ST3 – M Vella-Baldacchino, N Rupani

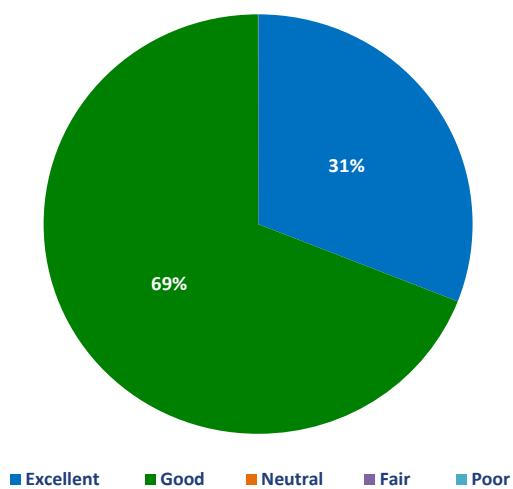
