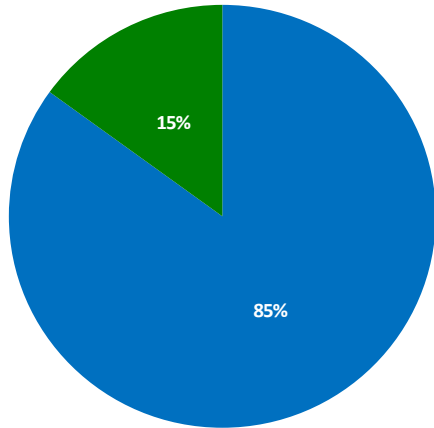

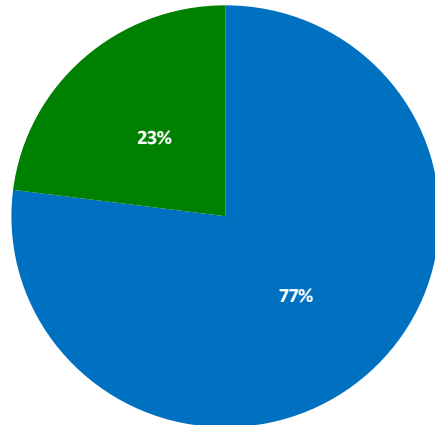

How was the content of the conference?



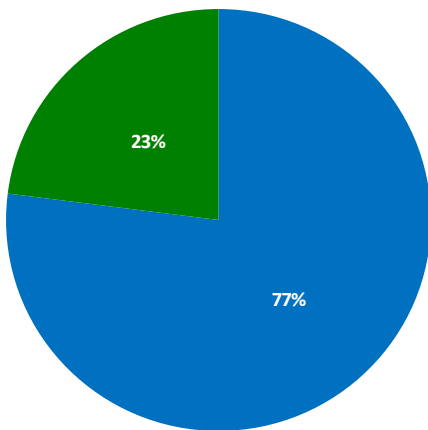

How would you rate the general academic standard of the speakers?



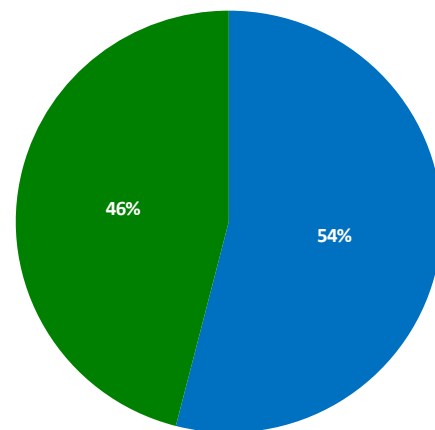

Principles of General Surgery - Mr McAleer



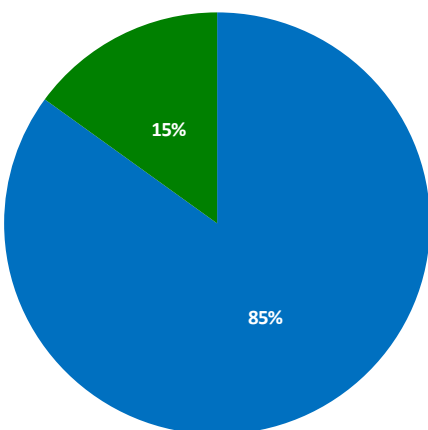

Principles of Laparoscopic Surgery - Mr Rajendran



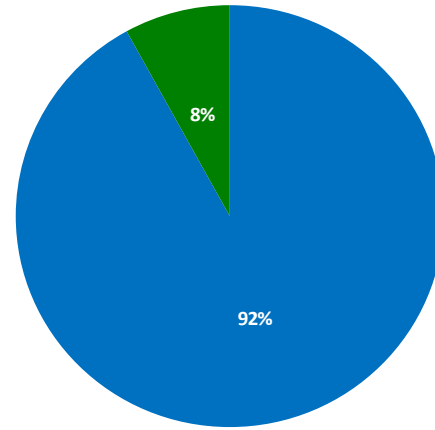

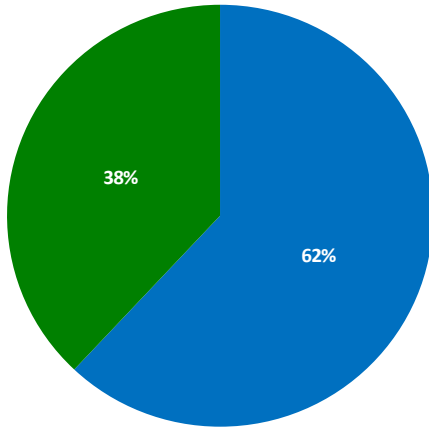

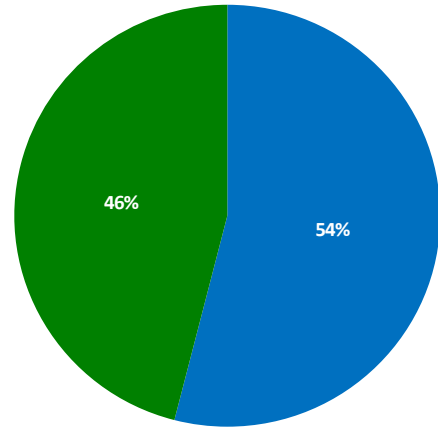

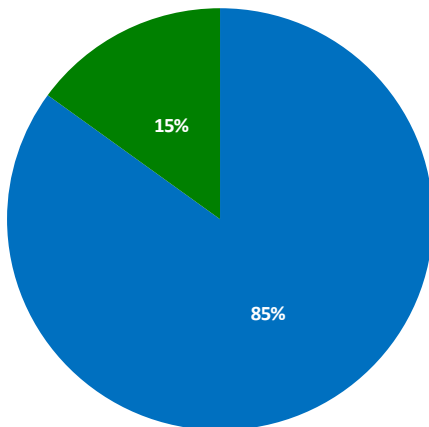

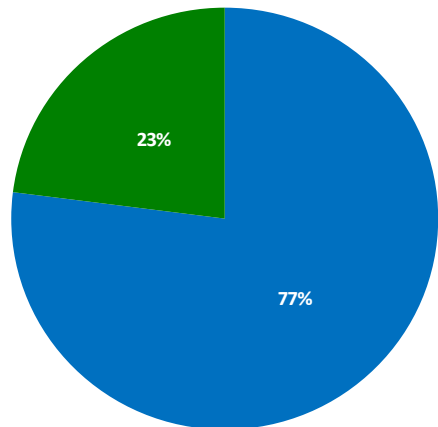

Life as a Core Trainee in Surgery - Dr Joshua Fasuyi



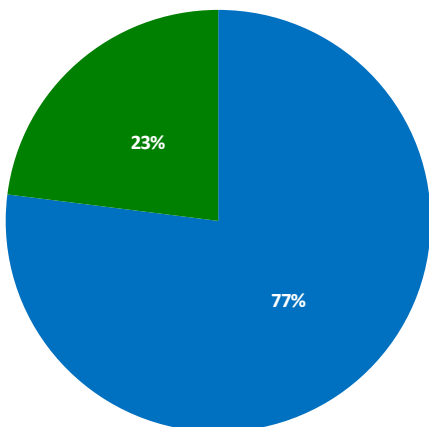

How were the facilities and venue?



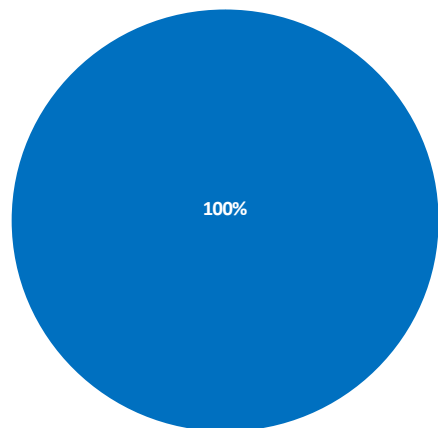

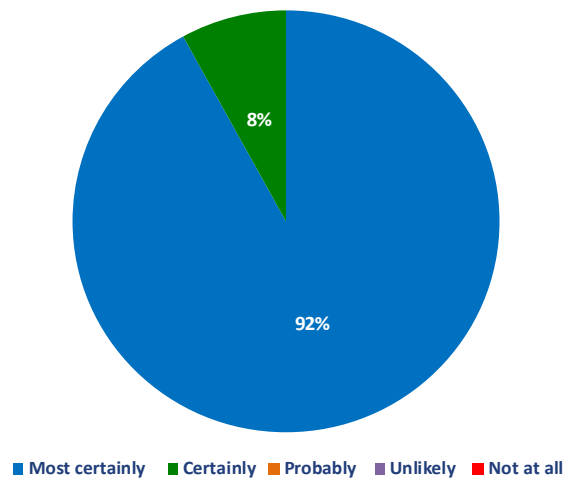
