

This one-day course was aimed at delegates who had declared a subspecialty interest in Breast Surgery at Section II of the Intercollegiate FRCS (Gen Surgery) Examination. It has been observed that generic FRCS preparation courses do not have the time to focus on each subspecialty, and as such, many delegates struggle with questions at an ST7 and ST8 level in their declared subspecialty. This course aimed to effectively address that pitfall and highlighted the key components and high-yield topics from the subspecialty of Breast Surgery within the JCST General Surgical curriculum.
