Follow signs for the Radiology Seminar Room.
- **From the Lyme Building entrance:** Turn right and follow the corridor past Subway. The Lyme X-ray Department will be in front of you at the end of the corridor. Follow signs for the Radiology Seminar Room.

- There is a regular bus service from Stoke Station to the hospital (Number 25) which alights opposite the main entrance to the hospital.

- Parking is available (£2.70 for the day) at the CCP Car Park on Hilton Road (ST4 6RR). It is a 5-10-minute walk from the Lyme Building. Walking from the entrance of the car park, turn left down Hilton Road to the traffic lights. Turn left into the hospital and follow signs to the main entrance.
